




The legal voters of the Town of Ira, Vermont are hereby warned and notified to meet at the Ira Town Hall on Monday, March 4, 2019 at 7:30 pm for an informational hearing and to act on Articles 2 -14, and to meet again at the Town Office, on Tuesday, March 5, 2019 between 10:00 am and 7:00 pm, to act on Article 1 by Australian Ballot.

Article 1.	To Elect Town Officers as required by State statute
Article 2.	To act on the reports of the Town Officers
Article 3.	Shall the voters authorize payment of real and personal property taxes to the Town Treasurer on or before October 22, 2019?
Article 4.	Shall the voters authorize the total expenditure of \$264,078 for the Town General Fund and Highway Fund for the fiscal year 7/1/19-6/30/20, for which \$131,927.84 will be raised by taxes and \$132,150.16 shall be from non-tax revenue?
Article 5.	Shall the voters appropriate \$7,936.80 to be raised by taxes for the Rutland County Sheriff's Department, in addition to \$12,000 included in the Town General Fund expenditures in Article 4 above for a total of \$19,936.80?
Article 6.	Shall the voters appropriate \$53,800 to be raised by taxes for the support of the Ira Volunteer Fire Department to provide services to the residents of Ira?
Article 7.	Shall the voters raise, appropriate and expend \$15,000 to start a reserve fund for the purpose of a fire truck replacement?
Article 8.	Shall the voters appropriate \$2,990.80 to be raised by taxes for the support of the Rutland Free Library to provide services to residents of Ira?
Article 9.	Shall the voters appropriate \$973 to be raised by taxes for the support of the VNA & Hospice of the Southwest Region to provide services to residents of the town?
Article 10.	Shall the voters appropriate \$300 to be raised by taxes for support of Southwestern Vermont Council on Aging to provide elder services to residents of the Town?
Article 11.	Shall the voters appropriate \$286 to be raised by taxes for the support of Rutland Mental Health Services so that these services can be maintained?
Article 12.	Shall the voters appropriate \$375 to be raised by taxes to support RSVP & The Volunteer Center (Retired and Senior Volunteer Program)?
Article 13.	Shall the voters appropriate \$250 to be raised by taxes to support BROCC – Community Action in Southwestern Vermont in 2019-2020?
Article 14.	Shall the voters appropriate \$250 to be raised by taxes to support the Bird's Eye View?
	To transact any other legal and proper business to come before this meeting.
