Popular Voice Syllabus

CATEGORIES

(Age as of December 31, 2018)

Junior Voice Age 14 & under	The Junior Voice category will include the following divisions: 10 yrs & under; 12 yrs & under; 14 yrs & under
Intermediate Voice Ages 15-18	The Intermediate Voice category will include the following divisions: 16 yrs & under; 18 yrs & under
Senior Voice Ages 19 - 28	The Senior Voice category is for participants, who are 19 to 28 years of age.
Open Voice Age 29 and over	The Open Voice c ategory is for participants who are 29 years and over.

CLASSES

- 1. **Early 20th Century Popular:** Select a song that first appeared on the popular music charts prior to the 1950s.
- 2. Mid 20th Century Popular: Select a song that first appeared on the popular music charts in the 1950s, 1960s, or 1970s.
- 3. Late 20th/21st Century Popular: Select a song that first appeared on the popular music charts in the 1980s, 1990s, 2000s, to the present.
- 4. Movie Songs: Select a song from the movies in any era.
- 5. **Canadian:** Select a song written or performed by a Canadian artist from any era.
- 6. **Duet:** Select a song arranged for two voices from the popular music repertoire from any era.
- 7. **Group:** Select a song arranged for three or more voices from the popular music repertoire from any era.

Popular Voice Rules and Guidelines

- 1. The Popular Voice category includes many styles of music. Participants are invited to perform in one or more of the following genres: Rock, Pop, Country, Folk, Rhythm & Blues, & Jazz.
- 2. Participants will enter one category, as determined by age.
- 3. Participants may choose to perform in the non-competitive division, but will not be eligible for awards and/or scholarships. This is determined at registration and cannot be changed prior to/or at the festival.
- 4. Participants can submit one, or more entries in Popular Voice. However, only one song <u>per class</u> is accepted. For example, a participant is not eligible to enter two songs in the Late 20th/21st Century Popular class, etc.
- 5. Acoustic accompaniment of any instrument(s) is allowed and encouraged. Pre-recorded music and/or tracks are **NOT** allowed.
- 6. Participants and accompanists <u>must use</u> original or authorized scores, which are required to be provided to the adjudicator prior to performing.
- 7. Memorization is mandatory. No song sheets on stage are permitted.
- 8. Participants are required to introduce their selection prior to performing.
- 9. Use of a microphone by participants during the performance is optional.
- 10. To be eligible for awards and scholarships, participants are required to enter in a minimum of <u>two different</u> classes in Popular Voice. For example, a participant can enter one song in the Early 20th Century Popular class and one song in the Canadian class, etc.
- 11. Popular Voice does not qualify participants for the Provincial Festival. (There is no Popular Voice category currently offered at the provincial level.)
