Plane Crashes into White Iron Lake

At approximately 11:08 PM on August 20, 2020, Lake County Dispatch received a call reporting a possible plane crash on White Iron Lake. The pilot, and only occupant, Dr. Kyle Edlund (58) of Woodbury, MN, was flying a Lance Air 4-seater, single engine N997S.

Dr. Edlund was last at his hotel in Ely at 10:15 pm. He flew out soon after leaving the hotel and ended up crashing into White Iron Lake. The plane was heading towards the Grand Marais/Cook County Airport from the Ely Airport.

Responding to the scene were the Lake County Sheriff's Office, St. Louis County Sheriff's Office, Lake County Rescue Squad, Morse-Fall Lake Fire Department and Ely Ambulance. Responders found the victim, Dr. Edlund, died on impact.

This accident is still under investigation.

They are pleased to announce the release of the 2021 Ely Winter Festival pin! As you know, the sale of pins helps to fund some of our expenses. In 2018, the Ely Winter Festival started giving \$1 from the sale of every pin to the Ely School District to support one of their arts programs, and for 2021, that will continue. While the MN State Art Board canceled their festival support grant this year, the festival's grant committee has been applying for new opportunities. The Festival has received support from the Arrowhead Regional Arts Council and the Gardner Humanities Trust.

According to festival coordinator Shauna Vega, "This is going to be a very special celebration, one we especially need this year! We are counting on people supporting us by buying our pins."
