



From Phoenix, AZ

1. Go north on Interstate 17 to Highway 69 (Exit 262). (62 miles)
2. Go northwest on Highway 69 to Fain Rd. (28 miles)
3. Go northeast on Fain Rd to intersection with Highway 89A. Continue going straight, you will merge onto Highway 89A. (5 miles)
4. Continue on Highway 89A (Pioneer Parkway) to Willow Creek Rd.
5. At the intersection of Willow Creek and Pioneer Parkway turn left (south). (1 miles)
6. Pass the first and 2nd entrance to Embry-Riddle and turn right onto Rummel Rd.
7. Turn left on Doberteen Drive and first left is Haas Chapel. (Retreat Meeting Room/Registration)
