Anyone convicted of two or more DUI offenses in ten years may be required by the D.D.S. to complete an alcohol and drug abuse evaluation (sometimes called a clinical referral); which can only be done by a DBHDD approved clinical evaluator.

We can provide you with a list of DBHDD approved evaluators and can arrange for your evaluation at the location of your choice. These are done by appointment only.

Level I Outpatient Treatment:

Multiple offenders may be required to complete an addiction treatment program. We provide Level I (outpatient) DBHDD approved substance abuse counseling at each of our offices.
