ORDINANCE NO. 362

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 215 AND RE-ESTABLISHING CURFEW REGULATIONS IN THE CITY OF ROLLA, LIMITING THE APPEARANCE OF CHILDREN UPON THE STREETS AND PUBLIC PLACES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLA:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any child under the age of 18 years to be in or upon the streets, alleys, parks or public places except schools and churches in the City of Rolla after 1:00 o'clock A.M., without the written consent of the parent or guardian of said child, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian or some adult authorized by such parent or guardian.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any parent, guardian, or other person having the legal care and custody of any child under 18 years of age, to allow or permit any such child, ward or other person under such age, while in such legal custody, to go or to be in or upon any of the streets, alleys, parks or pubic places except schools and churches in the City of Rolla within the time prescribed by the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 3. Ordinances number 28,35, 130, 161 and 215, and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Penalties. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be punished by a fine not to exceed \$50.00, or by imprisonment not to exceed 10 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court; the court to have power to suspend said sentence and to revoke the suspension therefore.

Section 5. Effective date. This ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon its final passage and the publication of its title and penalty clause.
