From Blairsville on Route 22 --- approximately 45 minutes

*****Note that there might be construction on PA-56, which will add more time.**

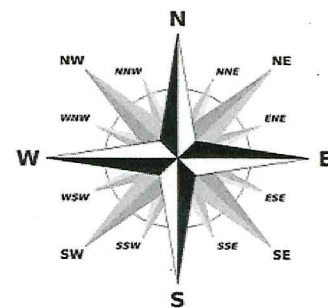
1. Follow US-22 E for approximately 12 miles.
2. Take the PA-56 ramp toward Brush Valley/Armagh.
3. Turn left onto PA-56. Go approximately 9 miles.
4. Once you get into Johnstown, PA-56 becomes Strayer St.
5. Strayer comes to a dead end with a gas station in front of you. Turn left onto Fairfield Ave/PA-56.
6. Turn right onto Broad St/PA-403. Continue to follow PA-403 S. for approximately 2 miles.
7. Turn left onto Walnut St.

The parking garage is to your right, next to Ideal Market.

From Greensburg --- approximately an hour

1. Take US-30 E.
2. Turn left onto PA-711/S Market St. in Ligonier.
3. Take the 2nd right from the traffic circle, continuing to follow PA-711 N.
---Stay left at the "Pickin Chicken" (Business is closed but sign is still there.)
---go right at the Sheetz to stay on 711-N
4. PA-711 N becomes Menoher Blvd., which takes you down into the city.
5. Turn right onto PA-271/Haynes St.
6. Take the 2nd left onto Napoleon St/PA-403.
---McDonald's is on the corner
7. Take the 3rd right onto Market St.
8. Take the 2nd left onto Lincoln St.

The church will be on your right. Continue to the end of the block, to Walnut Street. Parking is available to the right across the street from the church or to the left next to the Easter Seals. Once those lots are full, church members will direct you to the parking garage.



From Ebensburg -- approximately 30 minutes

1. Take US-219 S for 16.09 miles.
2. Merge onto PA-56 W. Go approximately 5 miles.
3. Take the Bedford Street exit.
4. Stay straight on Bedford Street past the light.
5. Make a left on Vine St.
6. Take the 5th right onto Market St.
7. Take the next left onto Lincoln St.

The church will be on your right. Continue to the end of the block, to Walnut Street. Parking is available to the right across the street from the church or to the left next to the Easter Seals. Once those lots are full, church members will direct you to the parking garage.
