

District 18 Inter-league rules

LOCAL LEAGUE RULES DO NOT APPLY NO GENTLEMEN'S AGREEMENTS

2017 Little League Baseball & Softball rules and regulations apply EXCEPT for the following regulations.

1. Time limits of games played Monday thru Thursday

a. **Minor Baseball & Minor Softball Divisions:** No new inning after **1 hour and 30 minutes.** Must complete 4 full innings unless rule 4.10(e) applies to be a regulation game. In the event of a tie at the end of the 1 hour 30 minute time limit play will continue one inning at a time until a winner can be determined.

b. **Major Baseball & Softball Divisions:** No new inning after **2 hours.** Must complete at least 4 full innings unless rule 4.10(e) applies to be a regulation game. In the event of at the end of the 2 hour time limit play will continue one inning at a time until a winner can be determined.

c. **Junior baseball & softball Divisions Senior baseball & Softball Divisions:** No new inning after **2 hours and 30 minutes.** Must complete 5 full innings unless rule 4.10(e) applies to be a regulation game. In the event of a tie at the end of the 2 hours and 30 minute time limit play will continue one inning at a time until a winner can be determined.

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2. **NO TIME LIMITS** will apply on games played Friday nights, all day Saturday and Sunday. The little league curfew applies on all games.

3. **Minor Baseball & Minor Softball Divisions ONLY:** A continuous batting order will be used. **5 RUNS PER INNING** except for the last inning which will be unlimited runs. The last inning will be declared by the umpire. In the event of "extra innings " unlimited runs will be in effect for those innings as well.

4. **Fines:**

1. All divisions in both Baseball and Softball a fee of **\$100.00** will be incurred for a no show payable to the host league . Also, if a visiting league shows up and the host team has to forfeit due to a lack of players, the host league must pay the fine to the visiting team. Each league must designate one "inter-league representative" . The representatives will contact each other in the case of these instances followed by phone call to the district inter-league officers:

2. Teams need to cancel a **minimum of FIVE (5) hours prior to the games starting time.**

3. leagues have FOURTEEN (14) DAYS to pay the fine and must be paid to the president of the league.

4. If no payment is made and/or when due, the district inter-league officers should be notified. if after FOURTEEN (14) DAYS the fine is not paid the offending team will not be allowed to inter-league until fines are paid. If any fines continue to go unpaid the offending league will not be allowed to compete in the TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS in any division.
