The Girl Scouts will be having their annual weeklong day/overnight camp on our grounds June 18-22. Please give them room, they will be everywhere.

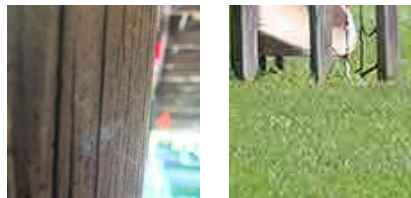
Look inside this newsletter for many new and exciting things happening; A new stream monitoring program, and new trail committee, and other hidden gems.

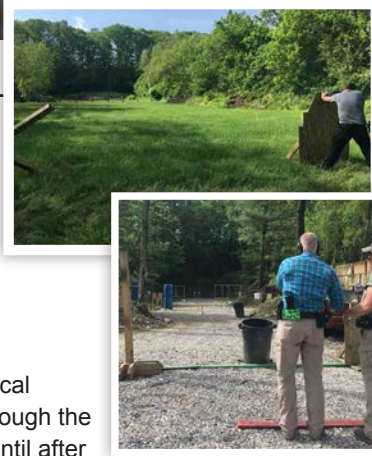
3 Gun

A fun day at the League by Lee Hankey

Last winter, a group of York Suburban students hatched trout eggs, they had received from the PA fish authorities, placed in aquariums in their classrooms and raised them into small viable fish. A few weeks ago they asked permission to release their pet fish into our stream to grow into even larger, hopefully trophy sized fish. These young trout were about 2 to 4 inches long when released. Last Tuesday it happened. The young trout soon disappeared in the ragging torrents of the East Branch of the Codorus Creek. A lot of the kids were concerned for the little fellows, but proud of their accomplishment.



240 students spent about 4 hours, in sometimes down pouring rain, identifying forest animals from hides, studying plant life cycles, spread out on the field learning about pollination and most fun of all, fishing and turning over rocks in our pond to find larva of the critters of the month (may flies, dragon flies and more). Mr Kornbaugh and Mr Fuhman gave them tours of our own fish nursery, a little larger scale from their classroom aquariums.

All and all, even though a little damp, the day went very well. These students and their leaders are a fine, respectable and a very neat group of young citizens. The students were told by their leaders to leave the grounds as they found them, and they did just that. Another successful bond of IWLA 67 and the local community.

Orientations Orientations, where we tour the grounds and discuss rules and features of the club are mandatory for prospective members, and interesting for existing members. The next three for 2018 will be: Sunday, June 3rd at 1:00 pm, Saturday, July 7th at 1:00 pm and Sunday, August 5th at 1:00 pm. Everyone is welcome to attend. We meet in the upper floor of the clubhouse.

Club Championship The Club Championship will be held July 22nd at 9:00 am. Think Youth Field Day shooting events for adults. We will shoot 4 events that day: One 25 bird round of trap, 25 clay birds at 25 yards with an iron sighted revolver or semi-auto pistol, 25 clay birds at 50 yards offhand with an iron sighted or scoped rifle, and 25 clay birds at 30 yard with a hunting class long, recurve or compound bow. No crossbows, magnification, or electronics on bows please. You use your own firearms, ammo, bow and arrows. The Club Champion will be the person with the highest cumulative score. You may shoot less than the four events. The fee is \$20. To pre-register send a check for \$20 made to "York Izaak Walton" to Howard C. Set up for the Club Championship will be at 9:00 am Saturday, July 21st. We will meet at the archery range.
