Georgia Southern pulled the biggest upset of the season so far beating Nebraska as 23.5-point underdogs on Saturday night. On Sunday, Nebraska fired head coach Scott Frost who was only 16-31 in 4-plus seasons in Lincoln.

#### Misleading Finals

Washington St (+17.5) upset Wisconsin 17-14. However, Wisconsin had a 401-253 yard edge including 174-53 on the ground.

UL-Lafayette beat Eastern Michigan 49-21. ULL was +5 in TO's.

### Bad Beats

The total in the Duke/Northwestern game was 56. Northwestern has the ball on the Duke 13-yard line with :17 left. They run on 3rd & 1 which fooled Duke. Just as the Northwestern RB was crossing the goal line, the ball got punched out and Duke recovered in the end zone to secure the 31-23 upset win as UNDER bettors cashed by 2 points.

The total in the Houston/Texas Tech game was 62. It was tied at 17-17 with :42 left. Houston got a FG to go up 20-17. Texas Tech was able to drive down and get the game-tying FG on the final play to force OT (20-20). OT is never the friend of UNDER bettors as Texas Tech got a 33-30 win.

For the 2nd straight week, if you bet the OVER in a Hawaii game you came up just short. Hawaii again failed on a 1st & Goal situation in the final minutes. Last week it was vs WKU, this week vs Michigan.

Temple (-14.5) only led Lafayette 21-14 in the 4Q but got a blocked punt with 1:37 left for a safety to get the 30-14 covering win. It was one of three blocked punts for Temple in the game.

- Arkansas S Jalen Catalon is out for the season.
- BYU WR's Gunner Romney and Puka Nacua are both questionable vs Oregon.
- Hawaii QB Joey Yellen will start again this week vs Duquesne.
- Iowa QB Spencer Petras remains the starter.
- Iowa WR's Nico Ragaini and Keagan Johnson returned to practice this week.
- Kentucky RB Chris Rodriguez will be available October 1st.
- Michigan QB JJ McCarthy will start again this week.
- Nebraska head coach Scott Frost has been fired.
- Notre Dame QB Tyler Buchner will have shoulder surgery, expected to miss the season. Drew Pyne will get the start vs Cal this week.
- Ohio St WR Jaxon Smith-Njigba could play this week.
- Ohio St WR Julian Fleming is expected to return this week.
- Oregon St TE Luke Musgrave is out this week.
- Pitt QB's Kedon Slovis and Kick Patti are both questionable vs Western Michigan.
- South Carolina defensive starters Edge Jordan Strachan and MLB Mo Kaba are out for the season due to knee injuries.
- Stanford OL Branson Bragg, a multi-year starter has retired (concussion).
- Texas QB Quinn Ewers is expected to miss 4-6 weeks (shoulder sprain). Backup Hudson Card is also questionable.
- UCF has cluster injuries at WR with Ryan O'Keefe, Amari Johnson and Kobe Hudson all questionable this week.

### Recapping Week 0/1 Best Bets

All of the College best bets were close. We didn't deserve a cover in the Tennessee (-6.5) game but somehow the Vols won by 7 over Pitt in OT. Texas Tech (-3) blew a 14-point lead vs Houston but then were extremely fortunate to win by 3 in OT. Some of you lost if you waited until game day to bet that one. Baylor (+3.5) probably deserved to cover but lost by 6 in 2OT to BYU and Oklahoma St was able to pull away late vs Arizona St. The teaser in the NFL was dead due to the Bills blowout of the Rams on the opening night. We did win outright with Pittsburgh (+6.5) but the Saints (-5.5) had to rally from 16 down just beat Atlanta by 1 on the final play.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

**Florida St 28 LOUISVILLE 27.** Our power ratings say Louisville is the play but the spot says Florida St with the Noles off a bye and Louisville off two tough games vs Syracuse and UCF. Look for the Noles to take advantage of a Louisville rush defense that is allowing 208 ypg. However, we don't see much value.

**Air Force 33 WYOMING 16.** Air Force has looked really good so far covering two similar point-spreads to this one by a combined 29.5-points. The Falcons are averaging 509 rush ypg (7.7 ypc!). However, Wyoming has allowed just 76 total rush yards the last two games. We bet Air Force -14 on the openers and still lean that way.

Saturday, September 17th

† **Cincinnati 37 Miami, Oh 14.** This game will be played at Paul Brown Stadium in Cincinnati so the Bearcats will have the big crowd edge. Cincy has won 15 straight in this rivalry including the last 3 by at least 21 points. Miami is playing with a backup QB but kudos to their rush defense allowing just 45 ypg so far this year. We gave out Cincy -20 to VIP clients but don't see as much value at -22.

**MICHIGAN 54 Connecticut 6.** The JJ McCarthy era begins as he will get his second straight start here for Michigan and has most likely won the QB battle over last year's starter Cade McNamara. He has more upside. Meanwhile, they are taking on a banged up UConn team already playing a 4th straight game and with a backup QB. Just like the last two weeks, UM can name their score. Lean OVER.

**Purdue 28 SYRACUSE 27.** Really solid non-conference match-up here. Syracuse is 2-0 ATS covering by a combined 40 points. You think offense first with these two coaches but both teams defenses don't get enough credit. Syracuse is allowing just 11 ppg and Purdue just 75 rush ypg. We bet UNDER 62.5 and still lean that way.

**Rutgers 32 TEMPLE 14.** Temple had a misleading cover last week (see page 1) in a 30-14 win over below average FCS Lafayette team. Meanwhile, Rutgers has dominated their first two opponents at the line of scrimmage with a 525-48 total rush yard edge. We expect more of the same here and bet Rutgers -16 on the opener.

**BAYLOR 42 Texas St 12.** Baylor came up short last week in OT at BYU as we lost on these pages getting +3.5. The Bears offense managed just 289 yards. Meanwhile, Texas St's defense is allowing just 294 total ypg so far but is taking a major step up in class here. We bet OVER 49.5 and still lean that way.

**INDIANA 33 Western Kentucky 29.** WKU, already 2-0 comes in off a bye. Meanwhile, Indiana is also 2-0 but we haven't been that impressed with the Hoosiers. They were very fortunate to beat Illinois and last week trailed FCS Idaho 10-0 at halftime. We bet WKU +9, we gave out WKU +7 to VIP clients and still like them at the current number.

**Georgia 36 SOUTH CAROLINA 14.** Georgia allowed a total of 3 first downs last week but couldn't come close to a cover as they were 53.5-point favorites vs FCS Samford. Meanwhile, South Carolina lost at Arkansas. How will the Gamecocks hold up at the line of scrimmage? They've been out-rushed 495-119 so far this season. We bet them +26 on the openers and still lean that way.

**3★ UNDER 67 Oklahoma 36 NEBRASKA 26.** Scott Frost is out at Nebraska and we think that is addition by subtraction. Remember, it's been tough to get margin on Nebraska. Each of their last 13 losses have been by single-digits including by 7 last year in Norman. We bet Nebraska +16, we gave out Nebraska +13 on the Covers release show and still lean that way. However, we prefer the UNDER. Sure both teams run some tempo, but the Nebraska offense gets their stiffest test yet and Oklahoma now has a defensive-minded head coach. Also note 15-plus MPH wind in the weather forecast!

**COASTAL CAROLINA 36 Buffalo 23.** This was one our favorite plays of the year earlier this week. The market way over-reacted to Buffalo losing to FCS Holy Cross. The reality is Buffalo was only a 6-point favorite and lost on a Hail Mary. The team that should have been downgraded in the market was Coastal. The Chanticleers were 32.5-point favorites vs Gardner Webb but got out-gained by 141 yards and benefited from +3 TO's in a 4-point win. We bet Buffalo +20, gave out Buffalo +19 as a top VIP play of the week and would still lean that way at +14.

**IOWA ST 34 Ohio 16.** Seems like a good spot to fade Iowa St after their first win over Iowa since 2014. The Cyclones' defense is allowing just 235 ypg and 9 ppg so far. Meanwhile, Ohio is off a blowout loss to Penn St. Tough to get margin with Iowa St's offense. We bet Ohio +22 on the openers but the value is gone.

**Utah 21 NEW MEXICO 20.** UTEP got outgained by New Mexico St last week. That's not good news facing an improved New Mexico team playing their 3rd straight home game. We bet New Mexico +4 on the openers and still lean that way.

**VIRGINIA 31 Old Dominion 20.** Old Dominion has already upset Virginia Tech this season so they are going for state bragging rights here. UVA was dominated at Illinois last week. The money has come in on ODU but it's tough backing either team as ODU is -168 ypg on the season. Pass.

**UCLA 37 South Alabama 21.** UCLA is 2-0 and outgaining their opponents by 320 ypg so far. However, a sharp betting group has been betting South Alabama the last two weeks and have been rewarded as the Jags are 2-0 ATS covering by a combined 47.5-points. They have outgained their opponents by 254 ypg and are allowing just 70 rush ypg. We were hoping to get +17 here. Pass.

**NOTRE DAME 25 California 16.** Notre Dame's season has taken a major turn for the worse as not only did the Irish lose outright as 20.5-point favorites vs Marshall last week. They also lost starting QB Tyler Buchner for the season. Drew Pyne will get the start here. How can you lay double-digits with an ND offense vs a Cal defense allowing just 14 ppg. We bet Cal +11.5 and +11.

**UNLV 31 North Texas 28.** Good barometer for both teams as they try to make a run towards a bowl game. UNLV is much improved and allowing just 71 rush ypg so far. They will get tested here vs a North Texas rush offense averaging 238 ypg. A market influencer is responsible for the early week money on UNLV. We lean UNDER.

**KANSAS ST 31 Tulane 17.** Kansas St has been super impressive so far at 2-0 but this is flat spot for them off a big win over SEC Missouri and a road trip to Oklahoma on deck. Tulane is also 2-0 and outgaining their opponents by 301 ypg. We bet Tulane +20 and gave out +15.5 to VIP. Obviously, some value has been lost.

**WISCONSIN 44 New Mexico St 6.** Wisconsin had a misleading loss as a 17.5-point favorite last week. Still, even with a new OC they can't find the end zone. The Badgers' defense remains stingy allowing just 55 rush ypg. They should shut down a New Mexico St offense averaging just 8 ppg. Lean OVER.

**Penn St 25 AUBURN 24.** Great non-conference match-up here. Two teams met in Happy Valley last year and played an instant classic. Penn St's offense has looked good averaging 41 ppg and 489 ypg. Meanwhile, Auburn (0-2 ATS) did struggle last week vs San Jose St. Still, the Tigers have out-rushed their first two opponents by a combined 495-128. We lean with the SEC home dog.

**2★ OVER 58 NORTHERN ILLINOIS 33 Vanderbilt 30.** We really like the OVER in this matchup. Vanderbilt games are 3-0 to the OVER by a combined 45.5 points as they have one of the most improved offenses in the country. Vandy games are averaging 72 total ppg. Meanwhile NIU games are 2-0 to the OVER averaging 68 total ppg.

**MINNESOTA 38 Colorado 10.** Minnesota is 2-0 with two blowout wins by an average of 45 ppg (+440 ypg). Meanwhile Colorado is 0-2 getting outscored by 28 ppg. More of the same here but we don't see too much value.

**Ole Miss 38 GEORGIA TECH 21.** Georgia Tech was outgained by FCS Western Carolina last week. Safe to say, it's going to be a long season in Atlanta. Now they take on an Ole Miss team that has outgained their opponents 497-162 on the ground. We bet Ole Miss -13 on the openers but prefer the UNDER now.

**OREGON 31 Byu 29.** BYU has been super impressive so far this season including beating us on these pages last week in their 26-20 TOT win over Baylor. However, this isn't a great spot for them. They had a long travel trip to Tampa in Week 1. Had an emotional game last week and now take on an Oregon team that took some frustration out last week vs FCS Eastern Washington. We prefer OVER here.

**2★ OVER 54.5 UAB 35 Georgia Southern 24.** It's probably a good "buy low, sell high" spot here. UAB is fresh off an upset loss to Liberty while Georgia Southern is off huge upset win over Nebraska. We prefer the OVER which is 2-0 in Georgia Southern games this season. The games have gone OVER by 16 ppg as they have successfully moved away from the option. GS is playing tempo (90 plays last week) and are averaging 388 passing ypg. We bet OVER 52.5 and still like it.

**APPALACHIAN ST 34 Troy 21.** ESPN College Gameday will be in attendance. There was nothing fluky about App St's upset over Texas A&M last week, they dominated the box score (+129 yards). We thought it might be a good spot to fade App St here off the big upset win but we needed +14 or better. Plus, we can't trust a Troy rush offense averaging just 59 ypg so far.

**HOUSTON 35 Kansas 25.** A lot of respected money has come in on the UNDER in this game. Houston has played a pair of multiple OT games leading to some misleading high scores. Their two games had a combined 48 and 40 points at the end of regulation. Unfortunately, we fell into a trap and bet OVER 62 on Sunday morning. Now we have one of our biggest negative EV bets of the season. Note Kansas has already passed some win totals (William Hill hung 1.5 early this summer).

**ALABAMA 57 UL-Monroe 6.** That was as bad of a performance by Alabama last week in any game since Nick Saban's first season. The Tide probably lose that game outright if Texas QB Quinn Ewers doesn't get hurt. Even then, the Tide needed a lot of things to go their way. We lean OVER.

**WASHINGTON ST 34 Colorado St 20.** Probably a good spot to fade Washington St after winning outright as 17.5-point underdogs last week in Madison. The Cougars got outgained by 148 yards. On the other side, what the hell was all that money on Colorado St last week? The Rams got bet up to 14-point favorites and then proceeded to get drilled by Middle Tennessee. Maybe we are glutton for punishment but we bet Colorado St +17 on the openers.

**WAKE FOREST 37 Liberty 23.** Even with a backup QB, Liberty got the upset win over UAB last week (+3 in TO's). It has to be worrisome though that their rush defense is allowing 247 ypg so far. Meanwhile, Wake got Sam Hartman back at QB and rolled over Vanderbilt last week. We bet UNDER as the Wake defense is allowing just 258 ypg.

**Marshall 35 BOWLING GREEN 20.** We thought it was a good spot to fade Marshall here off the big upset win over Notre Dame. We bet Bowling Green +20 on the openers and the market has agreed. Still, a little worrisome BG is off a TOT 4.5 hour game vs Eastern Kentucky last week.

**Mississippi St 28 LSU 27.** This is a really good barometer for both programs in 2022. Mike Leach should be further in Year 3 than Brian Kelly in Game 3. The Bulldogs are 2-0 ATS so far with a couple of impressive wins over decent competition. Meanwhile, it's tough what to make of LSU so far. Currently, we're not involved.

**OHIO ST 44 Toledo 14.** Early word this week is that Ohio St could get back both WR Jaxon Smith-Njigba and Julian Fleming here. They are 0-2 ATS this season and the Notre Dame win didn't age well so far. They're taking on a Toledo team that has outscored its first two opponents by 41 ppg (+244 ypg). We bet Toledo and UNDER on the openers and still lean that way.

**TENNESSEE 52 Akron 8.** This spread seems a little high considering Michigan St was just -34.5 vs Akron last week. On a neutral field, wouldn't you be betting Michigan St +13 vs Tennessee. It should be noted it looks like Akron QB DJ Irons is out for this game (maybe the season). Tennessee did not play well last week even though they covered vs Pitt. Lean UNDER.

**GEORGIA ST 40 Charlotte 20.** Charlotte is 0-3 ATS this season failing to cover by a combined 51.5-points. Do they get QB Reynolds back for this game? Meanwhile, Georgia St is off two respectable losses to South Carolina and North Carolina. At 0-2, they want a feel good win.

NC STATE 34 Texas Tech 24. A really good non-conference game here. Texas Tech was fortunate to get an OT win vs Houston last week after blowing a 14-point lead in regulation (still had a 468-354 yard edge). Meanwhile, NC State dominated an FCS opponent. We haven't bet side or total yet.

MEMPHIS 37 Arkansas St 23. The market was against us in the Memphis/Navy game last week (we bet Memphis -6, they closed -4.5). The market was wrong as the Tigers easily got the win and cover. Arkansas St is 2-0 ATS this season. However, we went right back to Memphis here and bet them -12 on the open. We also lean UNDER with Arkansas St's defense much improved.

Central Florida 35 FLORIDA ATLANTIC 25. If you're wondering why this line has dropped a bit, UCF has some cluster injuries at WR (see page 1). The Knights suffered an upset loss at home last Friday and need to get back on track. We didn't bet this game on the openers and still don't see value.

**2★ (USF plus the points) FLORIDA 39 South Florida 18.** After back-to-back physical tough games vs Utah and Kentucky, this seems like a flat spot for Florida with a road trip to Tennessee next week. Our pure power ratings already are strong on USF here. We bet +25 on the openers and are surprised this hasn't moved yet.

**3★ MARYLAND 37 Smu 31.** We bet Maryland -1 on the openers and gave them out as one of our top plays of the week at -2.5 to VIP clients. After blowing through "3" it's back down again in best bet range! SMU is 2-0 but still has a lot to prove with a first-year coach.

WASHINGTON 30 Michigan St 28. We're a little surprised to see Washington cross through the key number of "3" in this game. Both teams are 2-0 SU and 2-0 ATS. Both have played a MAC team and an FCS team. Washington is +36 ppg and +336 ypg. Michigan St is +37 ppg and +184 ypg. MSU was -3 to -4 in this game in the summer markets. We think there has been too big of an adjustment here.

Pittsburgh 33 WESTERN MICHIGAN 20. The big question here is the health status of the Pitt QB's. Kedon Slovis was KO'd vs Tennessee last week and Nick Patti was also banged up. HC Pat Narduzzi hasn't publicly said anything but as of now, this line is suggesting that Slovis is at least out. Pitt does have revenge for losing to WMU last year.

IOWA 30 Nevada 7. How can you lay more than 3 TD's with an Iowa offense that has scored a total of 1 TD in two games? Well Nevada did give up 55 points to an FCS team last week and Iowa looks to be healthier at WR. Our ratings like Iowa but we never got to the window.

UL-Lafayette 33 RICE 21. ULL is off to a 2-0 start but did benefit from +5 TO's last week vs EMU. Rice had bad TO luck vs USC (-4) but then were +5 last week in a blowout win over McNeese. Near the line for us. Lean OVER.

TEXAS 36 Utsa 23. This seemed like a good spot to fade Texas after their all-out effort vs Alabama last week. It's also the biggest game in school history for UTSA. Texas QB Quinn Ewers is banged up and backup Hudson Card was hobbled at the end of the game. UTSA is off back-to-back OT games. We lean UNDER.

CLEMSON 45 Louisiana Tech 10. Clemson got outgained by FCS Furman last week! They still aren't clicking on all cylinders offensively. LT is 1-1 SU/ATS. Another game that came right near our numbers.

TEXAS A&M 26 Miami, FL 20. Obviously, this one lost a lot of its luster with A&M upset loss last week. They are probably the right side to bounce back. Miami also struggled last week but pulled away late vs Southern Miss. Their rush defense is allowing just 59 ypg so far. We'll learn a lot about both teams but we're passing.

UTAH 36 San Diego St 16. Tough laying 3 TD's vs San Diego St but the Aztecs are -40 ypg this year vs Arizona and Idaho St. We prefer the OVER.

USC 42 Fresno St 30. USC's offense has lived up to expectations averaging 522 ypg so far and QB Caleb Williams is completing 80% with a 6-0 ratio. However, their rush defense was gashed last week vs Stanford. Fresno lost a heart-breaker to Oregon St last week but should be fired up here.

ARIZONA ST 37 Eastern Michigan 20. 11pm ET start for Eastern Michigan, how does their body clocks react late in the game. We did bet them +21 on the openers.

So far this season those games are 6-7.** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 8 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **South Florida +24.5**.

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

**HOME TEAM IN CAPS**

**KANSAS CITY 30 L.A. Chargers 24.** Last week KC was bet heavily and those pros were rewarded with a blowout win over ARZ. KC was +3.0 in yards per play. On the other side, LAC got a nice division win over Las Vegas. The Chargers notched 5 sacks and 3 INT's. The Chargers are 3-0-1 ATS their last 4 visits to KC but are in a tough spot traveling on a short week.

**Sunday, September 18th**

**BALTIMORE 24 Miami 20.** Both come in 1-0 with comfortable covers last week. Baltimore got out to a 24-3 lead vs the Jets and then allowed some garbage yards. Meanwhile, Miami benefited from +3 TO's as they were only +36 yards and +0.2 ypp vs New England. Baltimore has revenge for getting ambushed in Miami last year on a short week. Near the number.

**CLEVELAND 23 N.Y. Jets 18.** The Browns beat Carolina on a last minute FG last week and while they were -0.4 in ypp, they had a 355-261 yard edge including 217-54 rushing. It was remarkably their first opening season win since 2004! Meanwhile, the Jets saw Joe Flacco attempt 59 passes in the loss to the Ravens! We lean Jets here and that's where some of the early week money is.

**DETROIT 24 Washington 23.** Washington was -0.6 ypp vs the Jags last week in their 3-point win. That's pretty bad considering the competition and also might be one of the reasons this is the first time in 25 games that Detroit find themselves favored. The Lions final looked good in their shootout loss to the Eagles but the reality was they trailed big most of the game and were -0.5 in ypp. We think Washington is a good teaser option up to +7.5.

**Indianapolis 26 JACKSONVILLE 21.** The Colts underwhelmed yet again in a season opener last week. This time notching a tie vs the lowly Texans (hey at least they didn't lose like they had done every other year since 2013). Indy trailed 20-3 entering the 4Q and significantly won the yardage (517-299) and were +1.3 ypp. Meanwhile, Jacksonville had a solid but losing effort in Washington. Lean Indy but note their struggles with Jacksonville away from home (0-7 SU/ATS).

**2★ NEW ORLEANS 23 Tampa Bay 22.** The Bucs looked like the best team in the NFC last week as they destroyed the Cowboys winning the yardage 348-244 and were +1.8 ypp. We're expecting a little regression this week. While New Orleans was +0.9 ypp, they trailed Atlanta 26-10 in the 4Q before notching the game-winning FG. The Saints have owned the Bucs since Tom Brady arrived going 4-1 SU and limiting Brady to just a 8-to-8 TD-to-INT ratio. We think TB's offensive line issues could get exposed here.

**N.Y. GIANTS 21 Carolina 20.** Kudos for new Giants head coach Brian Daboll going for the win in Tennessee and he was rewarded. Remarkably, its the first time in 6 years the Giants are above .500. Meanwhile, Carolina continues to disappoint under Matt Rhule as they have now covered just 2 of their last 15 games. They got out-rushed 217-54 vs the Browns. How do the Giants handle the favorite role? They are also 0-10 ATS in home openers. Panthers are a good teaser option up to +8 with a low total.

**New England 21 PITTSBURGH 20.** No Brady and/or Roethlisberger here for the first time since 2001! We won outright on these pages with Pittsburgh last week but were fortunate as Pittsburgh was +5 in TO's. The Steelers got outgained 462-267 and lost TJ Watt for the season. Now they take on a New England team that has a ton of question marks offensively. The Pats only got 7 points last week and now QB Mac Jones is a bit banged up. With such a low total, we like the Steelers +8 in a teaser.

**L.A. RAMS 29 Atlanta 18.** With extra time to stew off their blow-out loss to the Bills last Thursday, we think the Rams are the right side here. The problem is we're never thrilled laying doubles in the NFL. Atlanta for 3Q's, was very impressive until a total collapse (sound familiar?). Keep an eye on the line of scrimmage. After notching just 18 sacks all last season, the Falcons got 4 last week. Meanwhile, the Rams allowed 7 sacks vs Buffalo (most in McVay's 6 years). Note the look-ahead line was -13.5.

**1★ SAN FRANCISCO 27 Seattle 16.** The 49ers dominated the box score vs Chicago as they had 331-203 yard and 4.9-3.6 ypp edges but somehow lost as 6.5-point favorites in bad field conditions. Meanwhile, Seattle is on a short week after an upset win (+6) over Denver in an emotional game vs their former QB. The Seahawks got outgained 433-253 and were -1.6 in ypp. Good "buy low, sell high" spot here for San Francisco.

**Cincinnati 25 DALLAS 18.** Obviously, we've seen a huge line move here from last week (Dallas was -1) as QB Dak Prescott is out with Copper Rush getting the start here for Dallas. The Cowboys were dominated at home to Tampa Bay last week. Meanwhile, Cincy outgained Pittsburgh 462-267 but were -5 in TO's in the OT loss. Teasing the Bengals down to -1.5 sounds good to us.

**1★ DENVER 28 Houston 16.** A very ugly start to the Nathaniel Hackett era as instead of putting the ball in your HOF QB hands, the Broncos elected for a 64-yard FG in their upset loss to Seattle on MNF. Denver had a 433-253 yard edge and were +1.6 in ypp. Now they take on a Houston team that got outgained 517-299 and were -1.3 ypp in a tie vs Indianapolis. Heavy chalk has become profitable in the NFL (see below).

**LAS VEGAS 28 Arizona 22.** Both playoff teams from last year can ill afford to start 0-2. We trust Las Vegas to rebound more than Arizona due to all the injuries for the Cardinals. Plus we expect a better performance out of Las Vegas QB Derek Carr who threw 3 INT's last week.

**2★ GREEN BAY 27 Chicago 14.** Another game where we could only look towards the big favorite after last week's results. Green Bay didn't score until they were down 20-0 to the Vikings but we expect a big rebound from Aaron Rodgers this week. Meanwhile, Chicago upset San Francisco but the Bears were outgained 331-204 and were -1.3 in ypp in sloppy conditions. Obviously, Aaron Rodgers has owned Chicago with a 22-5 SU record vs them.

**Monday, September 19th**

**BUFFALO 28 Tennessee 20.** Obviously, the Bills looked like world-beaters last week in their blowout win over the Rams. They have extra time to prep. Meanwhile, Tennessee was humbled at home as 5.5-point favorites to the Giants. Remember last year Tennessee lost their opener by 25 points to the Cardinals and then rebounded to win 8 of their next 9 games. We lean with the double-digit underdog but note each of Buffalo's last 14 wins have come by 12 points or more.

**PHILADELPHIA 26 Minnesota 24.** A really good matchup here between a pair of teams with playoff aspirations. Minnesota was dominant in a win vs Green Bay as QB Cousins now has a 35-to-7 TD-to-INT ratio going back to last season. Meanwhile Philadelphia allowed the back-door in Detroit in a shoot-out. Minnesota in a teaser up to 8.5 makes sense to us.
