Class Information Sheet

Classes will be held at 1220 Weil Street, Suite #4, Billings MT. There will be a maximum of six dogs in the class.

Dogs are masters at discovering the world through their noses, we are teaching them we want them to indicate a specific odor that has no other meaningful distinction to them. We are the student of the dog while learning to read the subtle changes in body language indicating he has located the odor source we want him to find. Handlers learn through practice and watching to become efficient, effective partners of the dog.

It is understood that your team (dog and handler) has the basic idea of this search game through attendance in an Intro to Nose Work class. If the team has not attended the class then acceptance to this class is only through discussion with and approval by the instructor.

ITEMS TO BRING TO CLASS

- Treats your dog absolutely loves (not likes, LOVES)
- LOTS of small treats—about pea size
- Flat collar or harness (no prong collars, gentle leaders, head halters, etc)
- A choice of leash lengths, 6 foot to 12 foot (no retractable leashes)
- Treat pouch
- Individual water bowl
- Crate and cover, if crating inside rather than in your vehicle
- Completed previous page with payment (check or cash) if not already sent

RULES DURING CLASS

- Only one dog at a time will be in the search area
- Plan to keep your dog in your vehicle or in a covered crate between
- When walking to and from searches please keep at least six feet distance between dogs
- Even if dogs are friends or housemates this is not playtime, it is learning time
- Watch each team as they are working to learn to notice the small changes of behavior (COB) when dogs are in the odor cone then at odor source
