

On the Boy's side of the double elimination Bakers format, Alton Boys, after dominating in the Match Play rounds, was eliminated with its 2nd loss in the 3rd round. Waterloo and Belleville East were the final 2 teams in the winners bracket. Waterloo lost to Belleville East in the winners bracket finals to drop to the loser brackets, leaving Belleville East Boys as the final unbeaten team. Waterloo then ran into Highland Boys who had fought back through 3 rounds in the loser bracket to make it all the way back to the Championship match after beating Waterloo. Waterloo finished 3rd. Highland and Belleville East tied after their 2-game baker match and proceeded with a 5 frame baker roll-off. Belleville East threw a 6 count on the fill ball to lose that match by 3 pins. Since that was Belleville East's first loss, the stage was set for a final Championship match between those 2 schools again. The first game Highland charged out fast with a 255 to Belleville East's 209 and coasted through the 2nd game to complete their run from the losers bracket to Championship. 1. Highland 2.
