All attendees who stay at Callaway Gardens during the Conclave will be granted free admission to the Gardens during their stay. All attendees to the Conclave who elect to stay outside the resort will be able to purchase a reduced rate pass to the Gardens for \$5.00. It will be purchased at the registration desk for the Conclave.

**Fishing**

Callaway Gardens offers some of the better trophy Brim and Largemouth Bass fishing in the South. These fish are not your normal “gills”. They are trophies and will test your skills as an angler. We have worked out opportunities for the discriminating angler to be able to sample the trophy fishing available with some basic rules. No license is needed to fish the waters of Callaway Gardens.

No private boats or float tubes will be allowed. The resort has made arrangements for discount boat rentals at Mountain Creek Lake with the fees set at \$7.00 for ½ day (one or two persons) and \$14.00 for full day rentals (one or two persons). The rental price is good from Thursday June 8, through Sunday June 11, 2005. Rates regularly range from \$30 - \$35.

Wade fishing at no charge will be available at Robin Lake, Chickadee Lake, and Martin Lake during (and only during) the following times: the prime time early morning hours for big Brim and Bass of 5 AM – 9 AM on Friday, Saturday and Sunday. Anglers must be out of the lakes by 9:00 AM as other Callaway guests are utilizing them also. Maps of the lakes will be available at the Exhibit Hall.

In addition there will be Semi-Guided Excursions available on Thursday from 4:00 – 8:00 PM, Friday from 6:00 AM – 10:00 AM and 4:00 – 8:00 PM, Saturday from 6:00 – 10:00 AM and Sunday from 6:00 – 10:00 AM. This will be a group outing of up to 5 anglers per guide and three groups available at each of the sessions. For a total of 15 anglers per session. The cost is \$40.00 per angler.

Callaway Gardens has numerous other activities that a family can enjoy. Please enjoy the Conclave and Callaway and tight lines and good fishing from the Southeastern Council of the Federation of Fly Fishers.

## 2006 SE FFF Council Conclave in Callaway Gardens

The 2006 Conclave will again be held in **Callaway Gardens**, June 9-10<sup>th</sup>! The Conclave is like a three-ring circus with activities going on in several different locations. The center of this activity is the Exhibit Hall that includes all the commercial exhibitors and the fly tiers who demonstrate a multitude of different patterns for warm, cold and saltwater fishing. The Exhibit Hall is open 9-4 Friday and Saturday and you can pick up some great gear through the silent auctions and raffles!! Registration for the 2-day event is only \$15 per family if you register by May 15<sup>th</sup>.

**Free seminars** will be given Friday and Saturday from 9-4 and **free casting instruction** will be given by the FFF Certified Casting Instructors from Callaway's Kingfisher Outfitters from 9-10, 11-12 and 2-3 each day. In addition a "Sage Casting Analyzer" will be on hand and for \$15 you can have your cast analyzed on the spot.

**Special "Fee" Classes** will also be given both days and pre-registration is required. These classes will be taught by some of the top instructors in the country and will cover, "Signature Saltwater Patterns" by Jon Cave, "Tying Tube Flies" by Tom Travis, "Deer Hair Flies" by Jim Stewart, and "Popular Bluegill Flies" by authors Terry and Roxanne. Wilson. Special "Fee" Casting Classes will also be given for those that want individual instruction. Those include, "Double Haul for Dummies" by Rhea Topping, Casting Techniques for Saltwater" by Jon Cave, "Loop Assessment" by David Lambert, "Roadmap for Certain Success in Preparation to take the Certified Casting Instructor Exam" by David Diaz, "Spey Casting" by Tom Jindra and "Beginning Women's Fly Casting" by Rhea Topping. All classes are \$35 for a ½ day class. Please note that there may be an addition charge for tying materials for some of the tying classes.

**Youth Program** - If you have children or grandchildren that are interested in learning fly-fishing there will be a "Free" Youth Program Saturday morning from 8-12 Noon taught by David Lambert. Advanced registration is requested so that Dave knows how many kids he should plan for.

**"Breakfast with Tom Travis"** will be Saturday morning and the cost is \$12 for the breakfast. **The Women's Outreach Luncheon** and Program will be Saturday at Noon and the cost of the luncheon \$20.

The final event of the Conclave is the **Live Auction** and dinner is Saturday night with a cost of \$15 per person. If you cannot make the dinner still plan to stop by for the auction, a lot of great merchandise including rods, reels, gear and artwork will be auctioned to the highest bidder. Guides from all over the southeast have also donated fishing trips and they will be auctioned as well.

**Fishing at Callaway!!!** No fly-fishing event is complete without fishing and there are several opportunities available thru Kingfisher Outfitters Fly Shop. Special prices are being offered to all that attend the Conclave.

**Boat Rental on Mountain Creek Lake:** \$7 for half-day rental (one or two pp); \$14 full day rental (one or two pp). Beginning Thursday June 8, ending Sunday June 11. Rates regularly range from \$30-\$55.

**Semi-Guided Excursion:** Available on Thursday from 4-8 PM, Friday from 6-10 AM, Friday from 4-8 PM, Saturday from 6-10 AM, and Sunday from 6-10 AM. This will be a group outing of up to 5 people with a guide on one of Callaway's private lakes. There will be 3 groups available at each of these sessions, meaning a total of 15 pp per session. Cost is \$40.

**Robin Lake:** Free wade fishing will be available on Robin Lake, Chickadee Lake and Martin Lake during (and only during) the following times: Friday, Saturday, and Sunday morning from 5:00 AM-9:00 AM. Fishermen must be out of Robin Lake by 9:00 AM as other Callaway guests are utilizing it also.
