GEORGIA SENATE PASSES TAX HOLIDAY ON GUNS & AMMO

Georgia Senate Bill 344 passed on a party-line 30-23 roll call this week. The proposal, should it become law in its current form, would establish an annual five-day sales tax exemption on not only guns and ammo but also optics, safes, and some other shooting accessories.

The bill needs to pass the GOP-controlled state House and be signed by Gov. Brian Kemp to become law.

Georgia has become a firearms industry success story in recent years with household names like Daniel Defense, Glock, Heckler & Koch, Norma, Remington, and Taurus calling the state home.

Should SB 344 become law, Georgia wouldn't be the first state to adopt a 2A holiday. Louisiana and Mississippi already have regular Second Amendment tax holidays, set for September and August, respectively. Several other states, including Missouri, Tennessee, and Texas, have considered similar legislation.



NRA Armed Citizen from February 2024 Magazine

On the morning of Nov. 5, 2023, a property owner in Brazos County, Texas, was forced to defend himself against an armed trespasser. The suspect allegedly first fired gunshots onto the property, then trespassed onto it and, with a gun in each hand, advanced on the property owner. As he advanced, the suspect allegedly threatened to shoot the homeowner and claimed he had shot his mother, which never happened. The property owner shot the suspect in self-defense. The man was rushed to the hospital and charged with aggravated assault with a deadly weapon. NSSF'S Firearm Ownership & Sports Shooting Participation Survey Reveals American Firearm

NSSF®. The Firearm Industry Trade Association, released the Firearm Ownership & Sport Shooting Participation in the U.S. in 2022 report. The report highlights 24.1 percent growth of adult participation in sport shooting in America from 2009 to 2022. Surveys indicate that during that time, sport shooting participation grew from 34 million adult participants to over 63.5 million.

Key survey findings showed the most popular types of recreational sports shooting for adult participation in 2022 were target shooting with a handgun, at 16.9 percent, target shooting with a rifle, with 15.6 percent and target shooting at an outdoor range, at 13.3 percent. The report also indicated that recreational target shooting at indoor ranges recovered to pre-COVID 19 levels, after an unsurprising dip during which pandemic protocols suppressed indoor shooting range participation. In 2022, 17 percent of all adults participating in the shooting sports were newcomers, a 42 percent growth since 2020 that reflected the similar changes in demographics as seen in firearm purchasers. Today's recreational marksmen and women are more representative of a broader scope of American demographic groups, increasingly urban and represented by women.


