# PROJECT HOPE: THE CHAPSTICK PROJECT

NCJW members have been visiting local hotels and motels leaving chapsticks to be placed at their front desks. The chapsticks are labeled with the National Trafficking Hotline phone number, and are available to all who enter the motel. We also provide pictures of local kids who are missing or exploited, and ask the clerks to call the National Trafficking Hotline if they have seen any of these kids.

We will next be visiting hotels/motels in West Palm Beach on both March 24th and April 22nd. So far, we have been advised that two missing girls have been sighted at places we've visited and we've informed the appropriate authorities. We never take action on our own.

Please mark your calendar appropriately, so that when the bus (aka my car) leaves Walgreen's (at the corner of Jog and Lake Ida) at 12:45 PM on those dates, you'll be with us.

Hopefully by the first of June, we will be bringing this program to Boca and Delray and you will become an important part of it.

Please let me know that you will be with us in March and April, and beyond. In the interim, feel free to bring chapsticks and lip balm to all our meetings. # ANTI-SEX TRAFFICKING SPEAKER'S BUREAU

Sex Trafficking is in the news every day, and we feel an enormous need to spread awareness of this very serious problem in South Florida. More than 100,000 American teens are trafficked every year. Florida is third in the nation in reported abuses.

Our Anti Sex Trafficking Speaker's Bureau has been regularly giving presentations on the horrors of kids being trafficked and we would like to share the information about our upcoming engagements.

We recently presented information at Ponte Vecchio Gesher Hadassah. Rosalie Almborg, Richard Davidson and Julie Fields Marx were our speakers.

On March 1<sup>st</sup> a presentation to the Democratic Party of Hollywood will be led by Arlene Davidson and Susan Kanoff, with another following on March 19<sup>th</sup> in Oakland Park by the same speakers..

In May we will be making a presentation to Congregation B'nai Israel Sisterhood led by Elaine Abrams and Barbara Silman. Renee Markus very graciously arranged this for our speakers.
