Brush Pick-Up

The final fall brush pick up at the curb is scheduled for the week of October 16th.

- Pile brush at the curb pointing the cut end with the flow of traffic.
- Small brush must be set out in an open container or CLEAR bag.
- Trim limbs down to 8 feet or less and no greater than 4 inches in diameter.
- Brush must be set out at the curb before 7 a.m. on Monday of the scheduled pick-up week.
- Please do not set out brush more than 5 days before the scheduled Monday.
- Brush generated by tree removal contractors is the responsibility of the contractor and will not be picked up.
- You may also haul your brush, free of charge, to the Wyocena Town Recycling site on East Bush Road. They are open <u>Wednesdays</u> noon to 4:00 p.m. and <u>Saturdays</u> 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Leaf Disposal

Leaves will be picked up once this fall by Advanced Disposal; the week of November 6th -10^{th} . Please follow these few simple rules:

- Leaves must be set out at the curb before 7 a.m. on Monday of the collection week.
- Do not set out bags of leaves more than 5 days before the scheduled Monday.
- Leaves MUST be set out in see-through bags.
- Bags should be placed immediately behind the curb of the public street for collection.
- No garden waste or grass clippings are allowed. Please compost!
- You may also haul your leaves, free of charge, to the Town of Wyocena Recycling site on E. Bush Road. They are open on Wednesdays from noon to 4:00 p.m. and Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Open Burning

Burning trash and garbage is prohibited. Burning barrels are no longer allowed within the Village of Pardeeville. Fall burning of dry leaves and other non-offensive dry yard debris is only allowed from October 1st thru November 30th. Outdoor cooking and campfires are allowed per Village Ordinance but must be supervised at all times.

Trick or Treat Hours

Halloween "Trick or Treat" hours are set for Sunday, October 29th, 2017 from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Winter Parking Rules

Winter parking rules are in effect November 15th to April 1st. Between 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., park cars on the even house numbered side of the street on even-numbered days of the month, and odd house numbered side of the street on odd-numbered days of the month. When the depth of snow reaches 3" or more during any period of 24 hours or less, a snow emergency is declared and vehicles will need to be removed from the streets until 24 hours after the snow stops falling.

If You Have a Mailbox

The Village of Pardeeville will not be responsible for mailbox damage caused by the plowing of snow. Please make certain that your mailbox front is EVEN with or BEHIND the back of the curb and is not in need of any maintenance due to previous winters.

Christmas Tree Pickup

The Village will pick up your used tree the second week of January. Place the tree at the curb by Monday, January 8th, 2018.

Snow Removal

Don't forget that you must clear the snow/ice from your sidewalk within 24 hours after the snow has stopped. Snow/ice should not be deposited on the street.

"Adopt-a-hydrant": If there is a fire hydrant in your properties right-of-way, for your safety and the safety of your neighbors, please remove the snow around the hydrant.

Tax Collection Info

The Village Hall will be closed the following days for the holidays:

For your convenience, real estate taxes can be receipted for the 2017 year if postmarked on or before December 31st. The first half of your tax bill is due at the Village Hall by January 31, 2018. The final payment is due at the County Treasurer's office by July 31, 2018.

License Your Pet(s)

Please license your dogs and cats for 2018. You must bring in proof of rabies vaccination from your veterinarian's office. We will begin issuing license tags after January 1st.

Building Permits

Residents are reminded that permits must be obtained for most property improvements. Contact the Building Inspector, Jim Trebian of General Engineering at 608-697-7779, if you are in doubt or have questions. He is in the Village office on an as-needed basis, so please call first. When planning your construction project, please allow a two-week time frame for appropriate permits, estimates, locates, etc.

Hydrant Flushing

The Pardeeville Water Department will be flushing water mains the week of October 9th – 13th. Flushing will be done during the day from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Some discoloration of your water may occur. The Water Utility recommends that residents run water from the cold water tap and flush toilets until the discoloration clears up.

Now you can pay your utility bill online through Payment Services Network. PSN is a third party vendor which provides online, mobile, automated phone and live customer representative phone payments.
