

First Timer Advice

If this is your 1st CTCI Convention, here are somethings you should be aware of to help you enjoy and get the most out of your visit

- You must be a CTCI member, you may bring guests but they and children over 18 must be included on Registration form and pay \$50 each.
- You must register for the convention by filling out the registration form
- The registration fees are for the whole Convention Wed. to Sun., there are no reduced rates for only partially attending the Convention.
- Your registration must be sent in before the deadline. (If you are having your Thunderbird judged you will receive an additional form from CTCI in the mail to ensure your cars eligibility.
- You do not have to participate in all the events
- You do not have to stay at the Host hotel, however the room block rates are usually the cheapest
- When you arrive after checking in with the hotel, go to the registration table to pick up your credentials.
- Wear you name tag at all times around the Convention and be sure to keep your event tickets secure and ready for each event.
- You <u>must</u> attend the Judges and Owners meeting on Friday morning if your T-Bird is to be judged.
- Friday is the Concours day and the best time to see the best of the best, be aware when the judging is over many cars are put away. Time for finishing judging will vary.
- Stop and see your Regional directors, they plan to have tables at the Welcome Dessert event.
- If you need assistance during the convention look for a New Jersey Open Road Club member. Their shirts will have "Committee" on them and their (name tags may be a different color)
- Thunderbird people are the friendliest people you will find anywhere, anyone will be happy to direct you to where you can get answers.
