CEREMONY FOR INSTALLATION OF LAY MINISTRY OFFICERS

the ceremony. All elected lay officers should stand together during the ceremony.

Discipleship.

4. To study the Bible showing one's self a worker of God so as to encourage the faithful,

strengthen the weak, and help win others.

5. To acquire vital knowledge of the doctrine, history and polity of the CME Church.

As officers of this Local Church, will you exemplify these ideals in your personal lives and be

diligent in your efforts to help members of the organization of which you represent to live

accordingly?

Leader: Will you cheerfully and diligently perform your duties? Will you regard the office as a sacred

trust and consciously strive continually seek to justify the confidence of those responsible for your

election? Will you strive to be an example for other believers in: word, in conversation, in charity, in
