AMERICAN SADDLEBRED HORSE DIVISION

USEF RATED (Please Use USEF Rated Entry Form)

Beginning December 1, 2015, owners, trainers, riders, drivers and handlers of horses competing at USEF licensed competitions in all American Saddlebred sections must be current competing members in good standing with the American Saddlebred Horse Association (ASHA). See USEF Rule-SB101 Eligibility.

In order to compete, all horses must be registered with the American Saddlebred Horse Association or the Canadian American Saddle Horse Registry. They must be entered in their full registered names with registration numbers and under the name of the owner(s) of record with the ASHA or CASHA. A copy of the registration papers showing proof of ownership, or a copy of the papers with a Certificate of Eligibility to Show issued by the ASHA must be submitted with the entry form at the time of making an entry or presented to competition office before competition number will be released. Please send copies of these papers with your entry blanks.

Exceptions: Ponies shown in the harness pony section at a USEF regular competition show prior to Dec. 31, 1989. A copy of registration papers showing proof of ownership must be submitted with entry form at the time of making entry or presented to competition office before competition number will be released. For competition purposes, the maximum height of Hackney Ponies is 14.2 hands and the maximum height of Harness Ponies is 12.2 hands. Copy of card must be sent with entry form.

Refer to FR101.2. a. Horse Owners/lessees competing in Purebred & Part-Bred Friesian USEF licensed competitions must be members in good standing with the International Friesian Show Horse Association (IFSHA). In order to compete, horse owners/lessees must provide a copy of their IFSHA membership card and a copy of the horse's IFSHA membership certificate with entry form at the time of making entry prior to the competition, presenting to the competition office at the time of entry or by applying for their membership card and horse membership certificate at the competition but before the competition number will be released. b. Individuals signing the USEF Entry Agreement (i.e. rider, driver, handler, agent of an owner, and trainer) for horses competing in the Friesian division must be members of IFSHA or pay to IFSHA a non member fee for each competition in which competing. Horse owners/lessees must be members of IFSHA as required in FR101.1a. Exception: When a parent/guardian is signing for a minor, they do not have to be IFSHA members or pay the IFSHA non-member fee. 2

Open to All Breeds and Riders

USEF Recognized – No USEF Points

(Please use USEF-Rated Entry Form.)

For exhibitors new to USEF recognized shows. Classes are open to all breeds. No USEF memberships or Show Pass (non-member) fees are required. However, if the rider is a member of USEF or the horse has been issued a USEF Horse ID number, those numbers must appear on the entry blank. Exhibitors are exempt from the USEF Federation/Drug fee if showing only in the Opportunity Division or are showing in the Opportunity Division and Non-USEF Recognized Divisions, such as the Academy Division and/or the Tennessee Walking Horse Division.

Show clothes are optional and, if used, should match the style of riding; but a long-sleeved shirt, long pants, and boots with a heel are required as a minimum regardless of style of riding. For English classes, either hunt or saddle seat equipment may be used. For Western classes, western equipment is required. No training tack allowed in any class. Riders/horses may cross enter into other classes at the show, but all applicable fees and membership requirements apply. No prize money will be paid.

Horses will be asked to flat walk, perform the medium gait, and canter both ways of the ring in each class except the Halter All Breed Open Opportunity, Leadline, and Obstacle classes. Horse must give the distinct appearance of being a pleasure to ride and display a pleasurable attitude. To be judged on manners, performance, quality, presence and conformation. Special emphasis is placed on a true flat walk.

Canadian horses born after Jan. 1, 1985 can be shown with Canadian registration papers as long as the papers do not state "not eligible for US reciprocity". Horses must be entered under the names of the owner(s) or lessee of record with AMHA, CMHA, or BMHS. Copies of registration papers showing recorded ownership or proof of lease and USA EQUESTRIAN current membership must accompany entry. TO BE ELIGIBLE TO COMPETE FOR REGION VII HIGH POINT AWARDS, YOU MUST BE A MEMBER OF A GOLDEN WEST REGION VII MEMBER CLUB.

This show is approved by the NAPHA as an All Breed Championship Show and is operated in accordance with the current OFFICIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS OF HORSE SHOWING & PERUVIAN BREED STANDARDS of the NORTH AMERICAN PERUVIAN HORSE ASSOCIATION. Rulebooks along with changes for 2019 may be obtained on the NAPHA website - www.NAPHA.net.

This show will earn a minimum of double points for NAPHA Awards if the recorded owner(s) of the horse is/are a current NAPHA member at the time of the show-Year end Awards-Medallon de Plata, High Point Performance Horse/Gelding, Zone 2 and Lifetime Awards-Medallon de Oro, Medallon de Bronze and Medallon de Diamante.

Registration and Entry: Horses must be registered with NAPHA (formerly PPHRNA & AAOBPPH) or the PHAC. Horses must be entered based upon the current, registration papers - registered owner, full registered name & number. A current copy of the front and back of each horse's registration certificate must accompany the entry form.

- Male horses 4 years of age & older must be registered as a stallion or gelding.

Registration papers indicating "male" will not be considered acceptable registration papers. The only exception will be male horses entered in Colts 3-4 in Bozal.

- Spayed mares may not be shown as a breeding mare.

New NAPHA rules pertaining to Amateur/Professional: Anyone competing in a class or Division declared for "Amateurs" only must have a signed NAPHA Amateur Declaration on file with the NAPHA. Amateurs must file annually. Regardless of one's equestrian skills and/or accomplishments, a person is an amateur if after their 18th birthday they have not engaged in any of the activities identified in PART X Glossary of Terms, Section 10 Professional, of the NAPHA Show Rules. Every person who has reached his/her 18th birthday and competes in classes for amateurs under NAPHA rules must be listed on the NAPHA website as an Amateur or have signed a NAPHA Amateur Declaration and filed with the show secretary, prior to the start of the show that morning of the class entered. Amateur status will be issued only on receipt of the application properly signed and is revocable at any time for cause. Any person who has not reached his/her 18th birthday is an amateur and does not require amateur status. See PART X GLOSSARY OF TERMS for complete definition of Amateur and Professional, of the NAPHA Show Rules.

Junior Riders: All Juniors must wear helmets. Retranca is prohibited, batacola is required. Floron is optional and pella is prohibited. Juniors 12 and under are allowed to use leather covered work stirrups.

Note: Any exhibitor who is delinquent in payment to a NAPHA approved show shall not be permitted to enter this show.

Champions and Champion of Champions from 2018 NAPHA US National Show, as well as the 2018 Carousel Charity Horse Show, shall be allowed to enter directly into the appropriate Championship class at this show in the appropriate division. This does not include any Best Bozal or Best Gaited Horse of Show class.

RULES FOR THE ACADEMY DIVISION

General:

1. Horses are NOT judged. Horses in the Academy classes MUST be lesson horses used regularly in a professionally operated lesson program. These horses must display the characteristics of such.
2. All Academy classes are to be judged on the ability of the RIDER to control and show their horses to the best advantage.
3. Academy Equitation classes are judged on BASIC equitation skills with correct diagonals and leads.
4. Academy Showmanship classes should be judged on the rider's horsemanship abilities. The horse is NOT supposed to be judged. It should be judged on the rider's ability to control and show their horse. Promptness in finding the correct diagonals and canter leads are important as well as the rider's command of the horse; for example: speed, placement in the ring and collection.

5. Headers are allowed in the 9 & 10 and 8 & Under Walk/Trot classes only after the judges' cards have been turned in. No towels, whips or aids of any kind are allowed.
6. Disputes shall be submitted in writing to Show Management, whose decisions are final.

Riders:

1. No full riding suits allowed (no hats, derbies, or jackets). Neat Jodhpurs with dress shirt and Jodhpur boots are required. Vest and tie are optional. Any exhibitor may wear protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) and/or a protective safety vest specifically designed for use in equestrian sport in any division or without penalty from the judge. Helmets required for exhibitors age 17 and under.
2. Riders must be participating in a professionally operated program and show on lesson horses.
3. A rider may own his/her horse as long as the horse is REGULARLY used in a lesson program.
4. A rider who has shown in a regular division or in a full suit is prohibited from further participation in the Academy division with the exception of Show Rider Practice.
5. Once a rider has shown in Walk/Trot/Canter classes, a return to Walk/Trot classes is prohibited. You cannot show in Walk/Trot/Canter and Walk/Trot at the same show. Riders showing in Walk only may not show in Walk/Trot.
6. Academy riders may not show in any other division at the same show with the exception of driving classes.

Horses:

1. Horses must be flat/keg shod. Corrective shoeing will be allowed without excessive pads. Soundness is not to be considered.
2. Horses may be shown in snaffle bridles with martingales. Pelham and curb type bits (martingales discouraged) are allowed at the discretion of the instructor. Please use caution when biting horses for beginners. Flat cutback English type saddles are to be used, unless the calls for alternative tack, such as Western or Hunt.
3. Academy horses may be cross-entered into show divisions at the same show. Show horses (horses not used in a professional lesson program and shown regularly in show performance or equitation classes) may not be cross-entered into the Academy Division.

ACADEMY DIVISION

(Please use Non-Recognized Form)

The Academy division is designed to introduce new riders and potential owners to the joys of showing horses. Participants should be enrolled in a professional riding instruction program. While attempts are made to make Academy classes affordable by offering simpler awards, these classes should be judged with the same importance as any regularly judged show class.
