- 8 x 11" sketchbook or at least 4-5 pages of plain computer paper stapled together for notes and design.
- Comfortable small scissors with which to cut shapes. Large scissors like Fiskars are too big.
- 1 1/2- 2" bristle flat brush- inexpensive, 2-3 round brushes
- Smock, small hair dryer if available, any surface embellishment tools such as old stencils, natural sponges, roller Brushes
