

ORDINANCE NO. 454

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 115 OF THE SPRING LAKE PARK CITY CODE RELATING TO AMUSEMENTS

The City Council of the City of Spring Lake Park, Minnesota, ordains as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 115.03 of the Spring Lake Park City Code shall be amended as follows

§ 115.03 LAWFUL GAMBLING; CRITERIA.

Lawful gambling as regulated by M.S. Ch. 349, as it may be amended from time to time, is permitted in the city if the organization conducting these activities meets the following criteria:

- (A) It is licensed by the State Gambling Control Board;
- (B) It has maintained an address within the city for at least three years prior to the application, or it owns a commercial building within the city from which it operates;
- ~~(C) No organization may conduct lawful gambling at more than three locations within the city;~~
- ~~(DC)~~ The organization must strictly adhere to the requirements of this subchapter;
- ~~(ED)~~ Organizations which lawfully conducted gambling in the city before the effective date of this subchapter are not required to submit applications before the date of their next license or permit renewal; however, all organizations must comply with the terms of this subchapter immediately upon its passage and publication; and
- ~~(FE)~~ Premises authorized to conduct lawful gambling in the city must have an on-sale or off-sale liquor license or a club license permitting liquor on the premises.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall have full force and effect upon its passage and publication.
