

The Cottage Shop, also known as the Inside-Outside House, was a mail order home originally assembled in 1870 in Boston, then shipped by schooner to Altamonte Springs in 1873, and moved to Historic Longwood in 1973. It is one of the oldest prefabricated buildings in the U.S.

At 2:45-3 p.m., we will reconvene at 4 Rivers Smokehouse in Longwood--for barbecue food or dessert. Pick up your food order and join the group at the picnic tables outside the restaurant.
