

JCGC MINUTES 4-5-2018

The meeting was called to order by President, Tony Stiers, at 7:00 PM at The 1st Presbyterian Church in Sylva, NC..

Attendance: Tony Stiers, Livingston Kelley, Andy Eggers, Charles Buchanan, Tom Dill, Joe Schivinski, Tom Tabor, Mike Bowler, Jim Buchanan, and Robbie Pittman.

Livingston Kelley read the minutes from the last meeting. Tom Dill moved to accept and Joe Schivinski 2nd. Motion passed.

Tony S. read the treasures report, e-mailed from Karen Dean. A more detailed report will be available at the next meeting on April 26th.

Members were reminded that the meeting schedule is 7:00 PM on the 4th Thursday thru September.

In old business, there was discussion about a donation to 1st Presbyterian Church for the use of their facilities. Mike Bowler moved to make a donation. Discussion followed about the use of club funds. Tony explained the payout at the club championship and other uses of our annual income. Tom Dill 2nd the motion which passed.

Tony Stiers moved to donate \$100 to the church. Mike Bowler 2nd and the motion passed.

Discussion followed about why there is a 'gross' and 'net' champion in the annual Club Championship. Tom Dill explained that it has been the practice of the club to recognize both, so as to honor the years best in both categories.

Robbie Pittman passed out and explained his analysis of the club tournament winners based on Tee Box played and handicap. The report was excellent and professionally done.

Robbie Pittman moved that coordinators be allowed to be in the 1st group out in the following tournament. Joe Schivinski 2nd and the motion passed.

Tony passed out 2018 schedules, membership list and match play entry forms.

Mike Bowler asked (1) about ball drop placement, considering the club has its own local rules designating areas as lateral hazards and (2) how far from lie, if playing 'lift, clean and place' the ball could be moved. As to the lateral hazard, (1) it was reiterated that if a drop was to be taken rather than played as it lies, the drop must be taken from where the ball crossed the lateral hazard, and not necessarily from where the ball might be found. (2) With regard to 'lift, clean and place' it was decided that the placement could be no more than 1 club length from its original position and no closer the hole.

Joe Schivinski asked about players picking up their ball and NOT putting out. Rules state the person is disqualified from the tournament.

Tom Dill moved the meeting adjourn. Mike Bowler 2nd and the motion passed.
