These are guidelines for using isip data. Use your professional judgement and other data sources to place your students in groups that best meet their needs. For step 2, follow the sort on the left or right to begin with. For example: If a student is strategic (yellow) with their overall reading score and has a score of 240 on CMP, you would place the student on the right side of the chart. Then, if the student has a 230 on SPL and a 25 on TF, you would still place them in Group C because their CMP was high enough to keep them on the right side of the folder. However, use other data, such as Lexile scores and the vocabulary subtest to determine possible movement to the group you know best meets their needs.
