Scholarship Application and Instructions

PRESBYTERIAN SCHOLARSHIPS

The Scholarship Committee of First Presbyterian Church is pleased to announce the availability of a limited number of scholarships for individuals in our church community. To be eligible for consideration to receive a scholarship, a student must be an active member of the First Presbyterian Church of Bismarck or must have been an active participant in the life of the church for at least three years. The awards are given for students at any level of study beyond high school. An applicant may receive a scholarship for a maximum of four years; these need not be consecutive years. Graduate students may apply for scholarships, providing they are within the four year maximum.

HOW TO APPLY FOR SCHOLARSHIPS

Completed applications for a scholarship must be addressed to the Scholarship Committee of the church and filed with the church office by **5:00 pm, Monday, May 15th**.

The student should request a copy of his/her latest scholastic transcript from the high school, technical school or college they are attending, or last attended, be sent to the Scholarship Committee of the First Presbyterian Church of Bismarck for delivery no later than **5:00 pm, Monday, May 15th**. This is likely to be the fall semester transcript for current students. Do not send a high school transcript if you are currently attending, or last attended, a technical school or college.

Two letters of recommendation are required:

- Do not resubmit letters from a prior application. New letters are required for each year an application is submitted.
- At least one of the letters must be from an academic reference from the educational institution the applicant is currently attending.
- Letters from educational institutions attended in the past will only be accepted if the applicant is not currently in school.
- The other letter may be from a member of the First Presbyterian Church congregation, an employer, service organization or another academic reference.

The applicant must provide a one to three page typed letter describing the following:

- His or her current church related activities at First Presbyterian Church, if attending high school and/or other faith related activities if attending college.
- School and/or community involvement
- Career plans

There will be no discrimination as to nationality, sex, or race. The granting of these awards will be based on church life, academic record, personal character, and references. The amount of scholarship and designation of particular scholarship awarded will be determined solely by the Scholarship Committee.

Scholarship winners will be advised by June 15th of each year. Scholarship funds will be mailed directly to the college.

ALL FULLY COMPLETED APPLICATIONS AND LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION MUST BE RECEIVED IN THE CHURCH OFFICE BY THE STATED DEADLINE OF 5:00 PM, MONDAY, MAY 15th TO BE CONSIDERED.

NO EXCEPTIONS WILL BE MADE.
