## Know Your Lease

### CLAUSE #4: RENT

Per the lease agreement, it states:

*Rent payment is critical! No excuses will be accepted for non-payment, including ill health, accident, loss of job, financial problems, family emergencies, etc.! Failure to pay rent when due will result in immediate termination of this rental agreement and eviction.*

Unfortunately, excuses for not paying are not accepted. Regardless of what is going on, rent is expected to be paid.

## Move Requests

### GOOD STANDING/30 DAY NOTICE

When tenants are looking to move, there are a few protocols that must be done. The process first begins with submitting a written 30-Day Notice to our office and your section 8 office. Per our lease, you **must** submit at least a 30 day notice to vacate. The second most important step of this is being in good standing, If you are not in good standing, Go2Guy and your Section 8 office cannot honor your move. any tenants with a balance are NOT in good standing. If you have questions, reach out to our office.

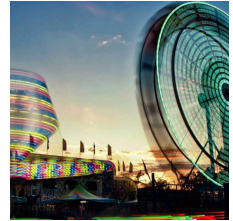
## Detroit Lions Training Camp: July 29th – 31st
