## Rules

- I. This contest is open to students from 9th through 12th grades.
- II. The theme this year is "TRACTOR SUPPLY COMPANY"
- III. Students must create an exciting visual display in a shoebox. This shoebox display will represent a display in a store window. When you are creating this display, remember that your "goal" is to sell the product(s) that are in the display. Your display should make people want to buy the product(s).
- IV. Things to consider are: merchandise, type of display and setting, and theme. Be creative and make a fun display that fits the image of the business, appeals to the target audience, and reflects the season you choose. You want everything to fit together like it was meant to be there.
- V. There is no charge for this event, however, an entry form is required for each entry.
- VI. If any entry is deemed inappropriate by the fair committee or its representatives, that entry will be removed from the judging and from the display area. Do not include references to alcohol, drugs, tobacco, sex, violence, etc.
- VII. All entry **forms** must be received by the **Habersham County Extension** Office by September 3, 2019. Forms may be faxed to 706-754-5611. You may mail them to **555 Monroe St., Box 13 Unit 50, Clarkesville, GA 30523**. Mailed entries must be postmarked by August 23, 2019. Or you may drop them off at that address between 8:00-12:00 and 1:00-5:00 Monday-Friday.
- VIII. Entries may be delivered to the fairgrounds between 4:00 and 6:30 PM on Thursday, September 5, 2019 or to the Habersham County Extension office before then. Entries must stay at the fair until Saturday, September 14, 2019.
- IX. The Fair Committee will not be responsible for lost or stolen entries.
- X. All entries must be labeled in an inconspicuous spot with the student's name, school, and grade.
- XI. The Fair Committee reserves the right to cancel this competition if there is a lack of participation
- XII. Entry into fair contests provides the entrant free admission to the fair on Saturday, September 7, 2019. Multiple entries does not equal multiple admissions. Parents and other family or friends will not be admitted free of charge. We must receive your entry in order to grant access to the fair.

- XIV. Entries will be displayed until the end of the Chattahoochee Mountain Fair and may be picked up at the Habersham County Extension office the week after the fair closes. Larger entries will be handled at the discretion of the event coordinator.
- XV. Entries may be picked up at the Extension office after the fair. All entries not picked up by September 27, 2019 will become property of the Chattahoochee Mountain Fair and may be subject to destruction, use in promotional materials, or any other use deemed fit by the fair committee.
