Spray:

788 Folk Art Matte Sealer

Step 1: Scrape the seams off the greenware with a cleaning tool. Sand the seams with green grit. Wipe imperfections off the seam area with a moist silk sponge. Replace any detail lost from cleaning with a stylus or texture tool.

Step 2: Fire to cone 04.

Basecoat 2520 Christmas Spirit

Step 3: Mountain area, the Hair, Eyebrows and the Beard with Ash

Step4: Icicles with Titanium White

Step 5: Trees with Thicket

Step6: Pinecones and house with Asphaltum

Step7: Face with Butter Pecan

Drybrush 2520

Step 8: Mountain, Hair, Beard and eyebrows with Steel Gray. Let each coat dry completely. Using the same brush dip into Titanium White and drybrush the eyebrows, Hair and Beard up until the desired color is achieved.

Step 9: Trees with Sap Green, Using the same brush dip into Forest Moss and highlight the trees.

Step 10: Pinecones with Maple Syrup.

Step 11: House with Teddy Bear Tan until desired color.

Step 12: Face with Skintone allowing each coat to dry completely.

Finishing Touches:

Step 13: Paint the eyes with Titanium White. Use Cobalt Blue on Iris and fill in Pupil with Pure Black. Add an accent dot.

Step 14: Spray entire piece with Matte Spray

Step 15: Drybrush Pearl White over all the Icicles until color desired.

Step 16: Highlight Pinecones with Inca Gold

Basecoat 2521 Glacier Santa

Step 1: Mountain and Castle tower with Steel Gray

Step 2: Icicles with Titanium White

Step 3: Face on Santa and Doll with Butter Pecan

Step 4: Holly with Thicket

Step 5: Berries with Red Velvet

Step 6: Hair, Beard and eyebrows with Ash

Step 7: Dolls Dress with Midnight

Step 8: Boat with Red Velvet

Drybrush:

Step 9: Mountain with Steel Gray. Using the same brush dip into Titanium White and bring up until color desired.

Step 10: Beard, Hair and eyebrows with Steel Gray very lightly.

Step 11: Face with Skintone till desired color is achieved. Allow each coat to dry.

Step 12: Wreath with Sap Green.

Step 13: Dolls dress with Cobalt Blue

Step 14: Boat with Naphthol Crimson

Finishing Touches:

Step 15: Paint the eyes with Titanium White. Use Cobalt Blue on Iris and fill in Pupil with Pure Black. Add an accent dot.

Step 16: Paint on face of doll and Use Titanium White on Collar and sleeves.

Step 17: Paint in the windows of Boat with Pure Black.

Step 18: Spray entire piece with Matte Spray.

Step 19: Drybrush Pearl White over all the Icicles until color desired.

Step 20: Paint the bugle with Inca Gold.

Step 21: Lightly Drybrush the Holly with Inca Gold.
