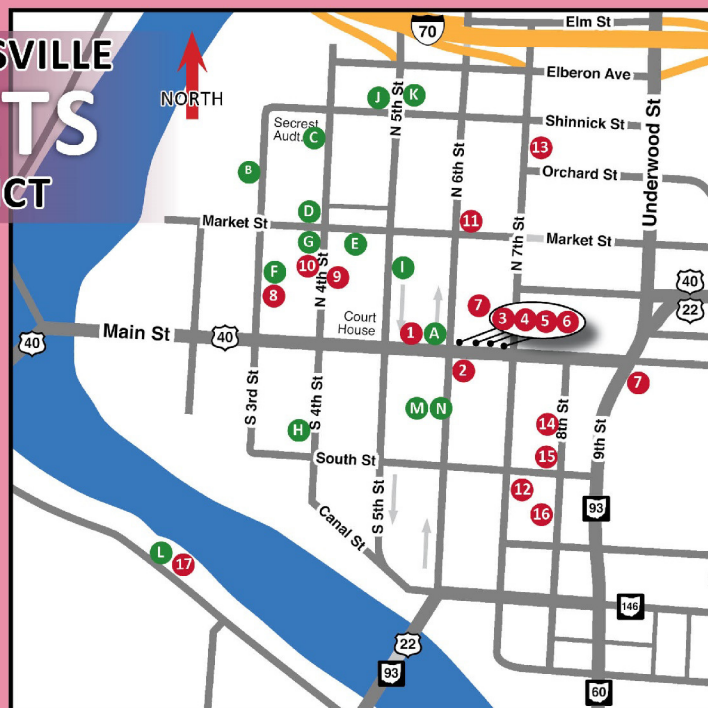

THE ARTS IN DOWNTOWN ZANESVILLE

We have been working closely with the Zanesville Health Department for the safety of our community during the Covid-19 pandemic. We are grateful for their hard work during these times. With guidance from the Health Department ArtCoZ will promote in person First Friday Artwalks again in May with the following guidelines: Proper Mask wearing at all times with proper hand sanitation stations. Artist of the Month



The Zanesville Museum of Art is currently conducting a full inventory of the over 8,000-piece permanent collection. This exciting process, which began in October 2020, is critical for the ZMA and will create greater accessibility for the public to utilize and research the museum's extensive collection. Furthermore, the Collection Inventory Project will allow the ZMA to refine the collecting plan and target artwork from underrepresented artists. The inventory will also allow the ZMA to develop the education collection, which will benefit local school outreach programs.



To follow along with the Collection Inventory Project, guests can visit zanesvilleart.org and follow the ZMA on Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram. View images of rarely seen objects from the collection, including American Art Pottery from significant companies like Roseville, Weller, and J.B. Owens.

While the ZMA building is temporarily closed, guests can stay connected to the ZMA through the robust series of Online Programming. Online programs at the ZMA include online jigsaw puzzles, docent tours, and a new program called ZMA Photo Hunt in which participants search for photos inspired by pieces from the collection. The ZMA is also excited to offer Live Online programming, including book discussions, Reel Meal film viewings, and online perspective lectures. 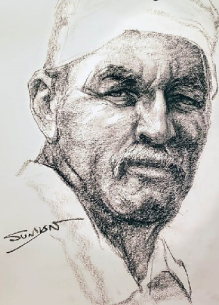
