

**CITY OF NEW MUNICH  
ORDINANCE 89  
OPTING-OUT OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF  
MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION 462.3593**

**WHEREAS**, on May 12, 2016, Governor Dayton signed into law the creation and regulation of temporary family health care dwellings, codified at Minn. Stat. § 462.3593, which permit and regulate temporary family health care dwellings;

**WHEREAS**, subdivision 9 of Minn. Stat. §462.3593 allows cities to “opt out” of those regulations;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW MUNICH, ORDAINS as follows:**


1. **That Ordinance 89 is hereby adopted which shall read follows:**


**“OPT-OUT OF MINNESOTA STATUTES, SECTION 462.3593:**

**Subd. 1:** Pursuant to authority granted by Minnesota Statutes, Section 462.3593, subdivision 9, the City of New Munich opts-out of the requirements of Minn. Stat. §462.3593, which defines and regulates Temporary Family Health Care Dwellings.”

2. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and publication.
