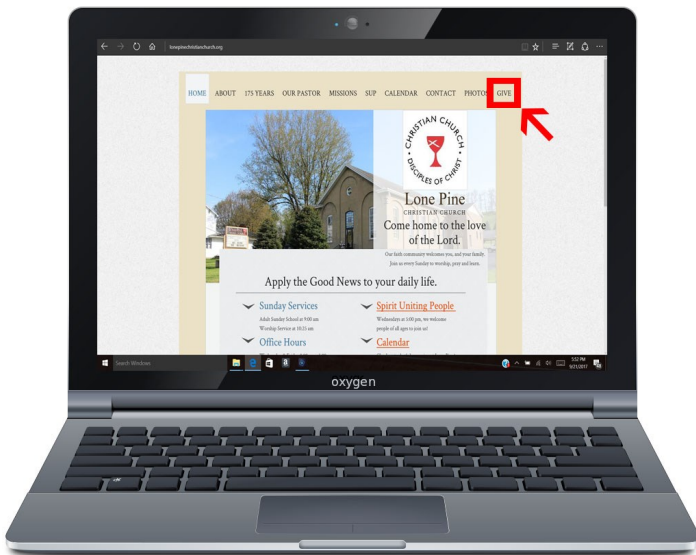

Each year in November we pack shoeboxes to send to kids all around the world for Christmas! We have started collecting items throughout the year, so that it is easier to have everything organized to pack during the first week of November. Here is a list of suggested items and what months we are collecting them. Please remember that all items must fit in a shoebox, not a boot box!

## We would like to be able to pack 80 shoeboxes...

so for the months that are past, I put how many of each item we still need

January—toothbrushes, toothbrush holders, and floss

February—Hair Accessories—Brushes, combs, hair ties, headbands, etc...

March—Small bibles, storybooks, devotionals for kids, etc...

April—Small stuffed animals or dolls

May—Notebooks/coloring books

June—crayons, markers, colored pencils

July—Small puzzles, games (cards, brain teasers, jump rope, ball with pump...)

Aug—Bars of Soap & washcloths

Sept—Pens, Pencils, Erasers, small pencil boxes or pouches, sharpeners

Oct—Small toys (cars, yo-yos, music makers, flashlight with batteries, etc...)

November & December—Money to ship the boxes—\$9 per box

Candy; toothpaste; gum; used or damaged items; war-related items such as toy guns, knives, or military figures; chocolate or food; seeds; fruit rolls or other fruit snacks; drink mixes (powdered or liquid); liquids or lotions; medications or vitamins; breakable items such as snow globes or glass containers; aerosol cans





# CWF—CHRISTIAN WOMEN'S FELLOWSHIP



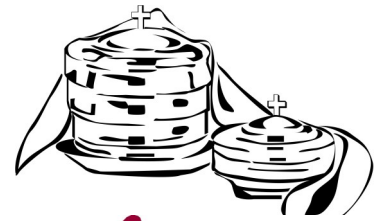
