15th Regional Juried Art Show November 7 – December 19, 2015

ELIGIBILITY: Open to artists age 18 or older.

- Paintings, drawings and photography works must be no larger than 40 inches in any direction, including the frame.
- Sculptures may not be taller than 6 feet total and each piece must weigh less than 50 lbs.
- All work must be original, completed within the last two years, and not shown at the TPS Gallery previously.
- Works must be wired and ready for hanging; no sawtooth hangers accepted.
- Water-based media and pastels must be under glass or Plexiglas.
- Accepted works must remain in the Gallery for the duration of the exhibit.

SUBMISSION: Entries must be hand-delivered and accompanied by the following:

1. Entry form and fee (maximum entry – two per artist)
Entry fees – Members: \$20 for 1st entry, \$10 for 2nd entry
Non-members: \$25 for 1st entry, \$20 for 2nd entry
2. Self-addressed stamped envelope
3. Label affixed to back upper left corner of entry, containing the artist's name, title of piece, medium, price, phone number and email address

Tryon Painters and Sculptors reserves the right to reject any entry that requires special installation if, in our opinion, the installation cannot be accomplished in our gallery. The submission of works to the exhibition constitutes an agreement.

AWARDS: 1st prize \$450
2nd prize \$300
3rd prize \$200
Honorable mention: gift certificates

LIABILITY: Reasonable care will be exercised in the handling of entries. TPS shall not be held responsible for any damage.

SALES OF WORK will be encouraged. TPS will retain a 40% commission.

JURORS: Dwight Rose for 2D entries and Todd Frahm for 3D entries

Dwight Rose is a graduate of the Ringling College of Art and Design, with a BFA in painting. He went on to teach both in Ringling's degree and community programs and at VCU of the Arts in Qatar. In his 30-year career, Rose has won numerous awards while his work has been included in many collections. International organization collecting his work include Exxon, Mobil, Qatar Petroleum, Qatar National Bank, Qatar National Tourism Authority and the Petroleum Technology Co of Qatar, as well as organizations in Florida and North Carolina.

Todd Frahm graduated from Illinois University in Champaign-Urbana with his BFA in 1998 and received his MFA in 2002 from Southern Illinois University, Carbondale. Frahm has exhibited nationally in Arizona, California, Illinois, Maryland, Pennsylvania and Tennessee and internationally in Canada and Korea. Frahm has also completed several large public works in California, Illinois, Indiana, Ohio and Missouri. He is interested in the visual dualities that exist between language and medium.
