Who We Are:

Long Island History Day (LIHD), is a yearlong, research-based educational program that encourages middle school and high school students to explore local, state, national, and world history. The program, highly regarded by Long Island public and private schools alike, culminates in a regional competition. Students from across Long Island will select a historical topic that relates to the annual theme, and conduct extensive research by using libraries,

archives, museums, and oral history interviews. The students analyze and interpret their findings, draw conclusions about their topic's significance in history, and create final projects in one of five dierent categories: Historical Paper, Documentary, Performance, Website, or Exhibit.

Winners from this regional level will compete at the state level at SUNY Oneonta. The state competition winners will be eligible to represent New York at the National History Day competition, in College Park Maryland.
