



NEEBING RECYCLING SORTING GUIDE



PAPER

- Fine papers
- Newspaper/flyers
- Catalogues
- Envelopes
- Soft cover books
- Junk Mail
- All writing paper
- Corrugated cardboard
- Boxboard (i.e. cereal boxes)
- File folders
- Business cards
- Clean pizza boxes



CONTAINERS

- #1 Plastic bottles with small neck and twist off tops only (i.e.: pop bottles, water bottles)
- #2 Plastic bottles with small neck and twist off tops only (i.e.: shampoo, dish soap)
- Milk cartons/Gable top containers
- Juice containers (Tetra Paks)
- Empty, uncrushed beverage cans
- Clean, uncrushed steel food cans



GARBAGE

- Items placed in any other bags besides clear or blue bags (i.e. grocery bags, black garbage bags)
- Bags that contain mixed paper and containers
- #3-7 Plastics, other plastics without a number
- #1 and #2 Plastic containers that are **NOT** a bottle type with a small neck and twist off top (i.e. margarine, sour cream types with flat lids, clam shells from deli and fruit and veggie trays)
- Bubble Wrap
- Plastic Pails
- Kids toys
- Styrofoam
- Waxed cardboard such as soap boxes/ coffee cups
- No metals other than food and beverage containers
- Hard Cover Books
- Carbon Paper
- Wallpaper
- Blueprints
- Wrapping paper



****Hazardous waste containers must be disposed of through a hazardous waste program. However, windshield washer fluid containers can be recycled.**
