

The Unexpected Adventure

I was watching a movie called "The Hobbit: The Unexpected Journey". It begins with a wizard named Gandalf, who travels to the Shire to invite Bilbo Baggins to an adventure. But

Bilbo was not at all interested. He liked life in the Shire. It was safe, simple, and comfortable. "No adventures here." So Gandalf persisted by challenging Bilbo's heart. He knew deep down that Bilbo had a desire for something beyond a safe life, and longed for an adventurous one. The next day, Bilbo changed his mind and joined Gandalf on this unexpected journey.

I believe deep down, each of us have a desire for something more than a simple and safe life. We may get comfortable with it. We may enjoy it for a while. But deep down, I believe we long for adventure. We just need someone to come along and invite us out of the Shire, and into that adventure. Jesus did that! He came into our Shire to send us out to make disciples. Listen again to Jesus as he says, "Follow me." It's an invitation to leave the comfort of what is safe, to join him on an adventure. What say you? Are you willing to go?

Pray and discern specifically what that looks like for you now. But don't take too long. Jesus is on the move in Hampton Roads. Join him for an adventure. You will never be the same.

This summer, put your best foot forward by brightening up a pair of flip-flops.


What you need: 🗳
