

December Quick Ties with Tom Regina & Art deTonnancourt

At the December 20th. Casting and fly tying clinic **Art deTonnancourt** will lead us in tying the “Yong’s Special”. The tools needed are a vise, bobbin, and scissors. The materials needed are a Mustad 94840 size 20 hook and white, or olive, or brown thread for the body and black 8/0 thread for the head. Your club will provide the materials and tools.

Instructions: Bend down the hook barb. Place the the hook in the vise. Start the body thread with a jam knot at the back of the hook eye. Wrap to the hook bend then return the thread to the tie in point. Wrap the thread up and down the hook shank to form a tapered body stopping the wraps at the hook eye. Half hitch and cut the body thread. At the hook eye tie on the black head thread with a jam knot and form a small head about the size of the hook eye. Whip finish the head and cut the thread.
