Town Board Meeting 2-8-2021

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting of the Town of Eaton was called to order by Chairman Rick Christel at 6:30 p.m., Monday, February 8, 2021 at the Eaton Town Hall. The Pledge Allegiance to the flag was recited by all.

MEETING NOTICES: Meeting notices were posted at the Eaton Town Hall, Recycling Center, & Riesterer & Schnell, Inc. and the Town Website

ROLL CALL: Rick Christel, Chairman; Adam Schetter, Supervisor, Lewy Schema, Supervisor, Paulette Vogt, Clerk, Pam Schneider, Treasurer, and Craig Zipperer, Road Superintendent, were in attendance along with Randy Knier.

AGENDA: The agenda had been emailed previously. Supervisor Schema made a motion to accept the agenda, and Supervisor Schetter 2nd the same, motion carried.

MINUTES: The minutes from the January 11, 2021 board meeting had been emailed to the Board previously. Supervisor Schetter made a motion to accept the minutes, Supervisor Schema 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

PUBLIC INPUT: Randy Knier thanked the board for the recycling building that was built for the recycling center. It is working out very nice.

ROAD SUPERINTENDENT: Superintendent Zipperer reported on the many jobs he has been doing this month. In addition, he stated that he had to fix the brake chamber in Truck 551, and also fix the shocks in Truck 550. Craig is still having an issue with the oil in Truck 551. A suggestion of shortening up the oil change cycle or going to synthetic oil might be a solution. Craig will continue to monitor this.

Supervisor Schema asked Superintendent Zipperer if he had heard from the DNA on the permits on the waterway issue. Craig said he had not heard anything as of yet.

SUPERVISOR 1: No report

SUPERVISOR 2: Lewy Schema had a list of town residents that have been pushing snow across the road into the ditches. After some discussion, it was decided a letter would be mailed to each resident with the Town Ordinance so that the resident is aware that this should not be occurring. Superintendent Zipperer will get the list together and give it to the Clerk for mailing out said letters.

TREASURER' REPORT: Treasurer Pam Schneider reported \$723,020.44 was the ending balance for January in the Bank First Account. The Road Maintenance Account has a \$25,378.61 balance, the Road Equipment has a \$10,000 balance, Dog Fund has a \$1,025.56 balance and checking account interest at \$64.17.

Treasurer Pam Schneider also presented the board with a list of the Building Permits that had been done for January.

Supervisor Schema made a motion to accept the treasurer's report and Supervisor Schetter 2nd the same. Motion carried.

CONSTABLE'S REPORT: No report.

CHAIRMAN'S REPORT:

Chairman Christel stated that Randy Brandes from Town of Rockland had contacted him to get verification on what Town is responsible for the parts of the road on Marsh Road (Hwy W to the East). Town of Rockland would like to have this verification put into writing so that it is clear. Chairman Christel and Road Superintendent Zipperer will look into this and get back to the Board with what they find out.

Chairman Christel reported he received a letter about a resident wanting to have two burial plots at the cemetery that the Town takes care of. Superintendent Zipperer will check out the information in the book he has on said cemetery.

Approve Vouchers: January Vouchers were paid with a motion from Supervisor Schema and a 2nd from Supervisor Schetter in the amount of \$700,608.37. Motion carried.

MEETING REPORTS: Chairman Christel and Superintendent Zipperer will be in contact with Town of Rockland board to decide about the responsibilities of each town for the work on Marsh Road

MISCELLANEOUS: Chairman Christel noted that there is a virtual meeting of the Manitowoc County WTA Unit on Thursday, February 18, 2021 at 7:00 p.m.

CLERKS REPORT: There will be an election on February 16, 2021.
