

**AGNES E. FEEKINGS**  
**1897 - 1977**

Agnes E. Feekings, age 80, of Elkton passed away Wednesday evening, July 20, at Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon, following a short illness.

She was born February 25, 1897 to Mark and Amelia (Vender) Coates in Fillion. She was a lifelong resident of the Elkton area, and taught for a number of years at Souletown school. Agnes and Blake Snider were united in marriage in 1917 at Elkton. They were farmers and also owned a grocery store in Elkton for six years. He preceded her in death. She remarried to Hubert Feekings in Kinde and he preceded her in death on August 14, 1962. Mrs. Feekings was a member of the Elkton United Methodist Church, the Blue Star Mothers and was also active in the Elkton Senior Citizens.

Mrs. Feekings is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Dale (Gertrude) Bowron, Mrs. Gordon (Greta) Sowden, and her daughter-in-law, Mrs. Melvin (Evelyn) Snider, all of Flint; Richard Feekings of Jerome; nine grandchildren; 20 great grandchildren; many nieces, nephews and friends.
