Last month I was lamenting the hot weather and now, Fall has arrived. I keep hearing reports that the Covid-19 numbers are on the rise. I know we have all been standing tall for more than eight months but let's not lose our focus now. Remember your masks, diligent hand washing routines and social distancing. Every single Legionnaire needs to come through this at the end healthy. Every one of you is important and we march together!

For Just a moment, I am going to switch hats to my District role to talk about an important opportunity for some of our sister and brother Korean War Veterans. I want to share information regarding the Republic of Korea - Ambassador for Peace Medal with you.

If you or a loved one served "in country" during the Korean War, you may be eligible for the Korean Ambassador for Peace Medal. This commemorative medal is an expression of appreciation from the Korean government to United States Veterans who served in the Korean War. The Ambassador for Peace Medal was first presented to Veterans as a special memento for those who returned to South Korea through the 'Revisit Program'. The honor has since expanded to Veterans who cannot travel the long journey to Korea. Criteria:

- To be eligible, the Veterans must have served during the Korean War from June 25, 1950 to July 27, 1953. Your service must have been "in country". The medal is also available for the Veterans who participated in UN peacekeeping operations until the end of 1955. You must have been on the Korean Peninsula and not just within the Korean Theater of Operations (Japan, etc).
- The commemorative medals may be awarded posthumously. However, please understand that the highest priority for presenting the medal is given to Veterans who are currently surviving in the United States of America. The next of kin, such as the spouse or descendants may apply for the medal on behalf of a deceased Veteran.
- 3. In order to apply for this commemorative medal, Veterans or their family members have to complete the application form. Veterans need to provide a copy of their DD214 or Discharge papers from Active Duty along with their application form for verification purposes.
- District Commander Schneeberger is coordinating submission of these applications. You can obtain an application from me by sending a request to adjutant dist29@gmail.com You will need to return the completed application and supporting documentation to me in person (do not email your documents) and I will process them through the District Commander. In your email make sure to include your current mailing address and a contact phone number in case I need additional information for follow up.

Applications will be presented to the Republic of Korea Embassy for evaluation of qualifications and the Korean Embassy staff will make the final determination on the award. It is important to understand that this is a program of the Republic of Korea Embassy. The American Legion is only assisting them in identifying eligible individuals and has no role in the final determination of award.
