

Author Steve Venables to Speak April 7th

Local author, Steve Venables, will speak at the Friends of the Library's Author Event on Saturday, April 7 at 10:00am in the Leake Room of the Woodland Public Library, 250 First Street. This event is free and open to the public.

There will be a "meet and greet" reception at 9:30am followed by a public presentation at 10am in which the author will speak about his book, <u>Visalia Class of '60</u>.



Author Steve Venables was born and raised in Visalia and graduated from Sacramento State before moving in 1969 to Woodland, where he started a travel agency. He owned and ran Woodland Travel for forty-five years, along with a chain of six branch offices in Davis, Sacramento, and Reno. Together with his wife Lydia he was able to travel the world frequently, and often his articles about their adventures were published in the Democrat. Later he was hired to create travelogues for an international travel magazine, and his column was voted the most popular in a tie with noted writer Rick Steeves.

This event is presented as part of a national monthlong celebration of reading called D.E.A.R. (Drop Everything and Read), designed to remind folks of all ages to make reading a priority activity in their lives.

Please join us on April 7, to meet Steve Venables and discover more about this local author and his work. Books will be available for purchase and signing.
