

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 45 REGULATING THE NUMBER  
OF "ON-SALE" AND "OFF-SALE" LICENSES PERMITTED AT ANY ONE TIME

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW MUNICH ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 45 entitled "An Ordinance Licensing and  
Regulating the Sale and Consumption of Intoxicating Liquor, Repealing  
In-consistent Ordinances, and Providing a Penalty for Violation hereof"  
is hereby amended by amendment of Section 10 as follows:

"Section 10. SUSPENSION AND REVOCATION

The Council may either suspend for not to exceed 60 days or revoke  
any liquor license upon a finding that the licensee has failed to comply  
with an applicable statute, regulation, or ordinance relating to intoxicating  
liquor. No suspension or revocation shall take effect until the licensee  
has been afforded an opportunity for a hearing pursuant to Minnesota Statutes,  
Sections 15.0418 to 15.0426.

The City of New Munich shall grant "On-Sale" and "Off-Sale" licenses  
by resolution of the City Council."

Section 2. Effective Date

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after  
its passage and publication as required by law.
