



Pastor's Paragraphs

Change is an inevitable part of life, yet change is also difficult which means that the interim time can be stressful and challenging. However, the interim also provides an opportunity for the church to make changes and grow in new ways. The changes we make together are ones that need to be intentional, so that we can function better as a church as we try to share the good news of Jesus with a world that has changed radically over the past generation.

As Christians we are always in an interim time – the time between Christ's first coming, his life, death, and resurrection, and before his

second coming. Life here as we know it is an interim. It is temporary, with changes happening all the time around us. We are constantly waiting – waiting in traffic, waiting for test result for the doctor, waiting to find out if our kids were accepted into a school, waiting in the check-out line at the store, waiting to hear if we got the new job, waiting and waiting...

In the meantime, while we wait, let's use this time to grow and change. I'm looking forward to spending this interim time with you, sharing in our common life, faith and worship of Jesus, our risen Lord and Savior.


Please be sure to check the bulletin board outside the church office any time you are visiting the church. It is full of useful information and announcements from throughout the community!



Shipwrecked Vacation Bible School

Who: Children ages 3 years** - 5th grade

When: Mon. June 18th - Fri. June 22nd from 6:00pm-8:45pm



There are many different ways YOU can help, some before VBS, some during...some behind the scenes, some with the kids each night. Either way, to make our VBS as successful as possible, we need YOUR help! Take a look at the opportunities to see where YOU can fit in:

Crew leaders: You are not responsible for teaching the VBS material in this role. They are responsible for taking a group of 5-8 children from station to station, talking with the children in your group, getting to know the kids and share God's love with them!

Bible Story Station Supply Helpers: This two-person team will find, gather, whatever props and things are needed for the Bible Story Teller. This 2-person team would work with the Bible story teller, to ensure that supplies are ready each night. At least one of the two people in this team needs to stay and assist the Bible story teller each evening as the story is told to each crew.

Station leaders: They stay in one place and are responsible for leading one particular thing. We need leaders for the following stations: <u>Imagination Station</u> (Science experiments and Crafts area), the <u>Bible Discovery Station</u> (where the Bible story is told to the children each evening), <u>Snack Factory</u> (the place where all kids and staff come to eat and fellowship), and the <u>Game Makers station</u>. If you are a station leader, all materials and lessons are provided!

Station leader helpers: These people help a particular station leader each night of VBS and possibly help the leader gather/organize materials and prepare the activities for each night.

Nursery Care: This 2-person group is responsible to care for any children (younger than 3 yrs. of age) whose parent is helping during VBS. This takes place in the cry room in the sanctuary.

Head Decorator: This person would be the lead for all the decorating throughout the church and Faith Hall. They would gather other people to help them do the decorating. The Shipwrecked Decorating DVD and Group's website both provide pictures and offer suggestions for how to decorate various areas of the church. Some supplies are ordered and we have some things in the attic, but this person should have some water/shipwrecked ideas to add to what is purchased.

Decorator: These people would work with the "head decorator" to transform the sanctuary and hallways into our shipwrecked theme as well as transforming the Bible Story room into the shore/jungle home for the week of Bible School. Some supplies are ordered and we have some things in the attic, but this person should have some water/shipwrecked ideas to add to what is purchased.

Donation Board Manager: This one or two-person group is responsible to create the donation board, and manage the collection of all the items that come in so we know what still needs to be purchased and what we have. This is done prior to VBS starting and does not require you to be at VBS. (There is a template you can use and help is available if you'd like it!)

The "Whatever is Needed" job: This one or two-person group is willing to show up the first two nights or VBS and is very willing to just be "around." They understand that they might be asked to serve as a crew leader, or maybe just asked to be a "runner" finding people, or relaying messages, or maybe not need to do a lot. This person or group is not out in front of people but is very important to have when those unexpected situations arise!

The Greeter: This one or two-person person group is asked to welcome parents as they drop their child off for VBS and answer any questions they might have about where their child goes, or other VBS questions. This person should be very comfortable talking with people and their children and making them feel at home with us!

Our pastor, Doug Marshall attended the meeting.

Denise opened the meeting with prayer.

Our balance as of 12/31/2017 is \$2,951.94.

We had 13 requests for help. We were able to help 4 with rent, love gifts and utilities.

10 Christmas baskets were packed by John, Brenda and Irene. They provided food for 20 adults and 18 children. They were picked up on Saturday December 16th.

There was a discussion about Holiday baskets and who could request and who could receive. Part of the discussion was about if a request was late. They will receive what we regularly give during the year instead of the special holiday basket.

We had 30 children's names from families we have helped throughout the year for the Angel Tree. Most of the gifts were picked up on the same day as the Christmas food baskets.

Denise reported that the neighbor of a member (who the member had requested help for) does not wish us to pursue help.

The McAllister's sent around a Thank You card for the Girl Scouts. They donated pantry items to the Deacons during their cookie kick-off. We voted to donate \$100.00 to the Girl Scouts for "Cookies for the Troops" that is sent through Sam's Pop Shop.

An anonymous gift of \$500.00 was given to the Deacons to give to someone we were aware that was in need. We took care of it.

Denise is continuing to update Deacon duties so they will be clearer. Any persons who are currently assigned a job are requested to list everything they have been doing and give it to Denise.

Ash Wednesday (Wed. Feb. 14) and Maundy Thursday (March 29) will be added to the Usher schedule.

Take note: Communion will be the second Sunday in April because Easter is the first.

The meeting closed with us praying the Lord's Prayer.

The next scheduled meeting will be Wednesday February 7, 2018 at 6:30pm.
