In my sermons and conversations I have observed how traumatized many of us feel these days and how much has gone wrong in the world just in the last few years. I told someone just the other day, "I don't know which to be most concerned about – Christian Nationalism or Climate Catastrophe." Or where to put my energy. I follow a God who rescues us from sin, death, and evil. I follow a God who raised Jesus from the dead, and in the power of the Spirit comes to me with nail-scarred hands and feet and a body all out of joint from hanging on a cross for hours. Talk about a balancing act.

We practice balance one day at a time, even one hour, or minute, at a time. We are not alone. We have each other and through each other we have the crucified and risen one standing, sitting, even lying down with us.

And it is enough.

Church Council Wrap Up

The Church Council met on July 24. Here is a summary of that meeting:

- Discussion was held regarding several up-coming projects at CLC and the top three were prioritized as follows:
 - #1 Fence staining (see notice on page 6)
 - #2 Turning the sand box into a Gazebo for use as an additional small group & meeting spot
 - #3 Moving the dirt pile
- The Council will be getting bids for tree trimming
- Another project being worked on by the Council is the refurbishing of the offices
- It was decided to hold a surprise pot luck brunch between services on August 14th to celebrate the 50th anniversary of Pastor Dale's ordination
- A follow-up discussion was held on whether CLC should register as a congregation for the Pride Parade set for October and how to gauge people's interest in participating
- Approved a compensation packet for Shelby Yuu, who will be taking over the duties of Office Administrator at the end of August (see her introduction on page 2)

The next Church Council meeting will be on Sunday, August 21, at 1:30 pm.

Dear Members and Friends of the Pacifica Synod,

This Sunday, July 31, will be my final day of serving as your bishop. I want to thank you for the honor of serving in this call. Thank you for the many prayers that I know were said on my behalf, both during services of worship and at times of private devotion. I relied on them, and they were helpful in doing my task. Thank you for the ministry that you have accomplished, for the ways you have shared the love of God with each other, your neighborhood, the surrounding community, and the world.
