Danderson stated the last 4 years during budgeting we have always put back \$20,000 with intent of that going into a new fund. The money was never saved back and we are sitting at zero for the Tractor Arm. He proposed that the Board authorize setting up a separate account putting \$20,000 out of the General Account. It should have \$100,000 now but it doesn't.

Veach asks what happened to the money in previous years. Danderson says it gets wiped out in General. We set this money back every time and now there isn't a fund there.

This would be a way to bank a separate restricted account and if we need to use it, then we have it. Veach asks with the wear and tear on that arm, what is the predicted time it will last. Danderson said yesterday. Icenhower says it won't last another 5 years. Kenny is constantly repairing it and if it wasn't for him then we wouldn't be using it. Veach asks if we can put more. Icenhower says that next year at budget, we need to look at it and see if we can put more or not. Roe clarified that this is for a tractor and arm.

We can always look at Capital Improvements depending where we are during budget time. It doesn't need to be huge amounts.

Icenhower says that all of the federal money that they are handing down, there is \$154,265 dedicated to the sewer. If we can get any of the DNR ARPA funds, we may be able to take some of the \$154,265 to put in the account.

We need to get a seed planted and get some money in the bank and next June we can look at it. Mayor asks Treasurer if there is anything we need to do . Brown says we can take the \$20,000 out immediately or do it every month. We can do \$2,000 a month transfers.

We should find out if we got the DNR ARPA Grant in the next two weeks. Brown thinks a restricted account is a good idea.

Beaty asks what the Capital Improvements account is for. Danderson said big ticket items. We don't want to get into the money if we don't have to. Beaty thinks we should put the \$20,000 in Capital Improvements instead of opening a new account.

Danderson says that setting up a new account is going to set it up for future boards. Icenhower says the Capital Improvements is more for emergency funds.

Tagged funds shows future boards what the intent was by previous boards.

Roe says when he became Alderman he was told that \$40,000 was set aside for sidewalk projects by the previous Mayor.

Danderson says that he thinks the word set aside changes when it comes time for budget and any money that was set aside and not used during the budget year ends up going back into the pot.

Motion by Danderson to open a restricted bank account at O'Bannon Bank for Tractor and Boom Arm Mower replacement and transfer \$20,000 from the General Fund to the new account. Icenhower Seconds.

Beaty said he sent a letter to DNR requesting that the deed be changed. There are four deeds that are a problem. Three deeds are involved in the Grant. There is a fourth one where the Huff Brothers donated the land. He is waiting to hear back from DNR. Mayor thanks the Committee for their hard work.
