The Father sent us The Son and The Son gave us the Eucharist!

This year, Father's Day and the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of The Lord (Corpus Christi) fall on the same weekend. This is fitting because we honor our dads for what they have done for us to make it possible to have a good life. And we should praise our heavenly Father for sending us His Son to die on the cross for our sins and give us the possibility of spending eternal life with Him in heaven.

We give our dads gifts on this day for the love they have shown us and Jesus loved The Father so much he gave His Father the gift of never failing obedience. Our dads can teach us how to be charitable to others and we in turn can give other people great gifts as well. Jesus' love for His Father made Jesus want to give us the gift of the Eucharist.

Even if our dads have passed away, we know their souls are eternal and they will always be with us spiritually. Jesus had to ascend to the Father, but He said He would always be with us and He is still with us in the Eucharist-Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity!

Let us who have had great dads be thankful to the heavenly Father for that and pray for those who have had terrible dads. We pray that they will realize that if their earthly dad has failed them, they still have a heavenly Father that will give them unconditional love.

I remember my dad showing me how important it was to go to Mass on Sunday and to put on my good clothes and good shoes. You had to be very, very, very sick to miss Mass in my family. My dad also showed me that you better treat Holy Days of Obligation like a Sunday Mass as well. Over time I came to appreciate the Eucharist more and more because I kept going to Mass every week. But when you go to Mass just occasionally (I'm speaking about healthy people), how can you nurture a strong love for the Eucharist?!

Are you excited when you get up to receive the Eucharist? Do you appreciate every opportunity you have to receive it? When you go on vacation, do you think? "Well I'm on vacation so I don't have to go to Mass?" (Wrong!) If you miss a Sunday Mass do you think attending a weekday Mass will make up for it? (Afraid not!) When you come up to receive the Eucharist, do you say, "Amen" or just nod your head? (You need to say Amen if you can talk.)

Dads are traditionally the head of the family and if a dad does not go to Mass every Sunday then why should the kids bother to go? Did you know that when the dad does not go to Mass, their kids are far more likely to not go as well than if the mom does not go? The greatest actions that a Catholic dad can do for his kids is to be a witness to them to love God, love the Mass, and love the Eucharist! Dads, if you teach your kids to 'seek these things first, then many other things will be given to them as well!'




