Putin and Erdogan talk Syria conflict and defense

The talks are taking place in the Russian Black Sea resort of Sochi and the Kremlin said that President Vladimir Putin was ending a period of coronavirus-related self-isolation by meeting Turkish President Tayyip Erdogan.

Turkish officials said before the meeting that Erdogan would press Putin for a return to a ceasefire agreed last year to end a Russian and Syrian army assault on Turkey-backed fighters in Syria's Idlib region.

A potential Turkish purchase of more Russian S-400 missile defense batteries is on the agenda too, something that Washington has made clear it strongly objects to.

Adani brothers in the most richest list

For the first time ever. both Adani brothers-Gautam and Vinod Shantilal-have been featured in the top 10 of the IIFL Wealth Hurun India Rich List 2021. With 505,900 crore rupees (\$76 billion), Gautam Adani became the second richest Indian billionaire, nearly quadrupling his wealth from Rs140,200 crore during the pandemic, while his elder brother Vinod Shantilal Adani grabbed eighth spot on the list, with his wealth tripling to Rs131,600 crore.

Gautam Adani has also now become the second richest Asian after Reliance Industries chairman Mukesh Ambani, overtaking China's richest billionaire Zhong Shanshan. Meanwhile, Ambani remained the richest Indian for the 10th consecutive year.







Jashne Noor celebrated in Chicago



India's misunderstood maharajahs

India's maharajahs or rulers of princely states are commonly viewed through stereotypes of elephants, dancing girls, and grand palaces. Historian Manu Pillai revisits their legacy.

If you look beyond the bejewelled figures, palaces and opulent courts, you'll notice something telling about India's maharajahs: that they have largely been scorned and mocked, or treated with voyeuristic curiosity.

The British, in their day, cast "native" princes as decadent figures, more interested in frivolous sex and fancy dress than in government.

One white officer, for example, loudly proclaimed the typical maharajah as "monstrous and bloated in bulk, hideous and disgusting in appearance" and "decked with earrings and necklaces" like a dancing girl. Unlike white men, these were not manly figures of authority, but effeminate "scoundrels".

The stereotype held for decades. In 1947, Life magazine joined the chorus through a statistical exercise which declared that the average maharajah had "11 titles, three uniforms, 5.8 wives, 12.6 children, five palaces, 9.2 elephants, and not less than 3.4 Rolls Royce cars".

It was all droll and entertaining, even if the numbers are misleading. After all, of the supposed total of 562 "states", most were microscopic estates with little political relevance.

To lump 100-odd bona fide princes, ruling over millions, with glorified landlords and aristocrats owning a few square kilometres of real estate, not only watered down their status, it also reduced them to a caricature: something akin to equating Queen Elizabeth with a country squire.

The fact, however, is that princely territories - spread over two-fifths of the Indian

subcontinent and not under direct colonial control but linked through treaties and agreements with the Raj as vassals - featured rulers who were anything but the stereotype of glitter and parade.

Maharajah's daring act of anti-colonial dissent

The lavish lifestyle of India's royalty

As Life acknowledged in the same piece, Cochin's maharajah was more likely to be found bent over a Sanskrit manuscript than in the lap of a concubine, while Gondal's recently deceased ruler was a trained doctor.

The big states were not ruled by "tin-pot" dictators drowning in wine and orgies, but by serious political figures, who saw their kingdoms as legitimate political spaces.

Of course, the charge of princely eccentricity has some truth - one maharajah saw a Scottish regiment and immediately dressed his brown soldiers in kilts and pink tights, while another is said to have believed he was Louis XIV reborn among Punjabis.

But India's princes hardly held a monopoly over such idiosyncrasies. British monarchs had just as colourful pasts, as did elected politicians; in fact, even a man like Lord Curzon - among the stuffiest viceroys sent to India - had it in him to once play tennis stark naked. The image of the maharajahs as "selfcentred fools", then, not only misses the more interesting story but actively conceals it, as I discovered while researching my new book.

Mysore's prince in southern India had elephants but also presided over a regime obsessed with industrialisation.

In Baroda, in the west, a journalist found that the maharajah there allocated \$5 to

every 55 of his subjects for education, as opposed to \$5 per 1000 people in British India.

Meanwhile Travancore, in present-day Kerala, was celebrated as a "model state" for investments in schools, infrastructure, and much else.

Indeed, it was in the princely territories that many early discussions on constitutionalism took off in India.

So why is it that we only talk of harems, flashy cars, and sex scandals, when we think about the princes?

The Indian queens who modelled for a vaccine

The Indian princess who became a South Korean queen

For one, it was a convenient line for the Raj, presenting colonial officials as well-meaning, upright nannies, struggling to discipline a band of spoilt (brown) schoolchildren. To acknowledge that brown men could not only govern, but also in many cases, beat the British would expose the empire's so-called mission to "civilise".

The story also plays down the paranoia and fragility which defined the Raj: though the princes were formally "pillars of the empire", in practice they were restive partners, forever testing their overlords.

Baroda, for instance, was the source of revolutionary anti-British literature, printed under such innocent titles as "Vegetable Medicines". Mysore would not tolerate the local press going after its royal family, but coolly allowed editors to criticise the Raj.

Jaipur's rulers cheerfully fudged their accounts, concealing millions in revenue

to avoid paying a higher tribute. Besides, multiple rulers provided financial support to the nationalist Congress Party in its fight for independence. Curzon, in fact, was convinced even in the 1920s that there were many "Phillipe Égalités" (after a Bourbon prince who supported the French Revolution) among the princes, with an "ardent sympathy" for the nationalist cause.

Odd though it may sound now, for much of the freedom struggle, the princes were actually seen as heroes.

The achievements of the bigger states brought pride to nationalists - including Mahatma Gandhi - dismantling as they did the racist trope that "natives" could not rule themselves.

But by the 1930s and 1940s things changed. In many principalities, often due to their own success in widening access to education, demands emerged for democratic representation. On the eve of the British withdrawal from India, many maharajahs became violently repressive, tarnishing their wider legacy.

The poor reputation the princes are saddled with today - where it does not stem solely from colonial stereotypes - comes from this endnote to their story.

But if history gives any lessons, it is that everything is more complex than it appears.

And this is true of the maharajahs also, among whom were deft modernisers and shrewd politicians - a detail for too long hidden behind stale talk of dancing girls and elephants.



Exclusive: Obama says US'desperately needs' Biden agenda, supports taxing the rich

President Biden's far-reaching multitrillion-dollar domestic agenda, in peril because of Democratic infighting, is getting a prominent boost from former President Barack Obama, who told ABC News in an exclusive interview that the country "desperately needs" the programs and that he supports taxing the wealthy to help support the package.

"You're talking about us stepping up and spending money on providing childcare tax credits -- making those permanent to help families, who for a long time, have needed help," Obama told "Good Morning America" host Robin Roberts.

"You're looking at making our infrastructure function more efficiently ... you're talking about rebuilding a lot of buildings, roads, bridges, ports so that they are fortified against climate change. And also, that we start investing in the kinds of energy efficiency that's going to be required to battle climate change."

The former president's comments come as ongoing disagreements between progressive and moderate Democrats in the House delayed a vote on a sweeping \$1.2 trillion bipartisan infrastructure bill that passed in the Senate on Aug. 10.

Biden tries to salvage agenda threatened by Democratic infighting

The legislation bolsters funding for the country's infrastructure -- from roads and bridges to transit systems and the electricity grid.

Progressives have indicated that they will not vote on the infrastructure bill until the larger \$3.5 trillion so-called "human infrastructure" bill is also ready for a vote, but some of the contents of the larger bill, as well as disagreements over how to pay for it have been a point of contention among Democrats.

The \$3.5 trillion bill is a 10-year spending plan that covers a host of Democratic priorities, including investments in health care, child care, eldercare, universal preschool, free community college, as well as efforts to combat climate change.

Republicans and some moderate Democrats have raised concerns over the price tag of the package, while House Democrats have sought to offset the costs by raising taxes on wealthy Americans and corporations -- a proposal that Obama said he supports.

"I think that they can afford it. We can afford it. I put myself in this category now," Obama told Roberts.

"It's paid for by asking the wealthiest of Americans, who have benefited incredibly over the last several decades -- and even in the midst of a pandemic, saw their wealth and assets rise enormously -- asking them to pay a few percentage points more in taxes in order to make sure that we have a economy that's fair for everybody," Obama said.

Schumer, Pelosi announce 'framework' to pay for \$3.5T infrastructure bill

"I think anybody who pretends that it's a hardship for billionaires to pay a little bit more in taxes so that a single mom gets childcare support or so that we can make sure that our communities aren't inundated by wildfires and floods and that we're doing something about climate change for the next generation -- you know, that's an argument that is unsustainable," he added.

Hoping to salvage his agenda, Biden met with members of Congress last week, including House Speaker Nancy Pelosi, D-Calif., Senate Majority Leader Chuck Schumer, D-N.Y., as well as Democratic moderates and progressives from both chambers.

White House press secretary Jen Psaki told reporters

Thursday that the administration is considering a "range of options" for financing the plan.

"Our bar has continued -- has always been from

the beginning, nothing that would raise taxes on anyone making less than \$400,000 a year. And certainly we wouldn't support anything that would," she added.

Pelosi may delay vote on Senate bipartisan infrastructure bill

Following the meeting with the president Pelosi indicated that a vote on the infrastructure bill in the House was set for Monday Sept. 27 -- a timetable that she has since indicated could change.

"I'm never bringing to the floor a bill that doesn't have the votes," Pelosi told ABC's "This Week" anchor George Stephanopoulos "You cannot choose the date," she added. "You have to go when you have the votes in a reasonable time, and we will."

A White House official told ABC News on Monday that Biden, along with senior White House staff, spoke over the weekend with several members of Congress whose votes are key to getting the legislation passed.

"Engagement is happening through the weekend into Monday and it continues to be clear that there is strong resolve across the caucuses behind passing these bills so that our economy delivers for the middle class and not just those at the top," the White House official said. America's Need to Pay Its Bills Has **Spawned a Political Game**

WASHINGTON — For nearly two decades, lawmakers in Washington have waged an escalating display of brinkmanship over the federal government's ability to borrow money to pay its bills. They have forced administrations of both parties to take evasive actions, pushing the nation dangerously close to economic calamity. But they have never actually tipped the United States into default.

The dance is repeating this fall, but this time the dynamics are different — and the threat of default is greater than ever.

Republicans in Congress have refused to help raise the nation's debt limit, even though the need to borrow stems from the bipartisan practice of running large budget deficits. Republicans agree the United States must pay its bills, but on Monday they are expected to block a measure in the Senate that would enable the government to do so. Democrats, insistent that Republicans help pay for past decisions to boost spending and cut taxes, have so far refused to use a special process to raise the limit on their own.

Observers inside and outside Washington are worried neither side will budge in time, roiling financial markets and capsizing the economy's nascent recovery from the pandemic downturn.

If the limit is not raised or suspended, officials at the Treasury Department warn, the government will soon exhaust its ability to borrow money, forcing officials to choose between missing payments on military salaries, Social Security benefits and the interest it owes to investors who have financed America's spending spree.

Yet Republicans have threatened to filibuster any attempt by Senate Democrats to pass a simple bill to increase borrowing. Party leaders like Sen. Mitch McConnell of Kentucky want to force Democrats to raise the limit on their own, through a fast-track congressional process that bypasses a Republican filibuster. That could take weeks to come to fruition, raising the stakes every day that Democratic leaders decline to pursue that option.

The problem is further compounded by the fact that no one is quite sure when the government will run out of money. The COVID-19 pandemic continues to ravage the United States in waves, frequently disrupting economic activity and the taxes the government collects, complicating Treasury's ability to gauge its cash flow. Estimates for what is known as the "X-date" range from as early as Oct. 15 to mid-November.

Amid that uncertainty, congressional leaders and President Joe Biden are not even attempting to negotiate a resolution. Instead, they are sparring over who should be saddled with a vote that could be used against them, raising the odds that partisan stubbornness will propel the country into a fiscal unknown.

It all adds up to an impasse rooted in political messaging, midterm campaign advertising and a desire by Republican leaders to do whatever they can to protest Biden's economic agenda, including the \$3.5 trillion spending bill that Democrats hope to pass along party lines using a fasttrack budget process.

Republicans say they will not supply any votes to lift the debt cap, despite having run up trillions in new debt to pay for the 2017 tax cuts, additional government spending and pandemic aid during the Trump administration. Democrats, in contrast, helped President Donald Trump increase borrowing in 2017 and 2019.

"If they want to tax, borrow, and spend historic sums of money without our input," McConnell said on the Senate floor this week, "they will have to raise the debt limit without our help."

Thus far, Biden and Democratic leaders in Congress have declined to do so, even though employing that process would end the threat of default.

Jon Lieber, a former aide to McConnell who is now with the Eurasia Group, a political-risk consultancy in Washington, wrote in a warning to clients this week that there is a 1-in-5 chance the standoff will push the country into at least a technical $\ \, debt\ default-forcing\ the\ government\ to$ choose between paying bondholders and honoring all its spending commitments this fall.

"That's crazy high for an event like this," Lieber said in an interview, noting that the odds are significantly higher than in past standoffs. "But I feel really confident that's the level of panic we should be having."

Under President George W. Bush, Democrats, including Biden, voted in 2006 against a debt-limit increase, citing Bush's budget deficits that were swollen by tax cuts and wars in Iraq and Afghanistan. They did so despite warnings from administration officials that a default would hurt the nation's credit rating and economy.

Biden, like many other Democrats, said he could not abet Bush's fiscal decisions. But his party did not filibuster a vote and Republicans were able to pass a debt limit increase along party lines. White House officials say Biden's vote was symbolic, noting that the ability of Republicans to raise the debt ceiling was never in question.

Leaders of both parties have, at times, made a version of the core argument in favor of raising the limit: that it is simply a way to allow the government to pay bills



it has already incurred. Both parties also have shown no sign of slowing the nation's borrowing spree, which accelerated last year as lawmakers approved trillions of dollars of aid for people and businesses struggling through the pandemic recession. Each party has recently occupied the White House and controlled Congress, but neither has come close in recent years to approving a budget that would balance which is to say, not require additional borrowing and a debt-limit increase — within a decade.

Biden administration officials, former Treasury secretaries from both parties and business executives from around the country have all urged lawmakers to raise the borrowing limit as soon as possible.

"I think it's scary for consumer confidence and for confidence in U.S. businesses and potential credit ratings if we don't make sure that we raise that debt ceiling," Andy Jassy, CEO of Amazon, said on CNBC earlier this month.

Democrats say Republicans have a responsibility to help raise the limit, noting that they helped when Trump needed to do it. White House officials called McConnell's position hypocritical.

"Republicans in Congress have spent a decade ushering in a new era where the prospect of default and a global economic meltdown has become a dangerous political football," Michael Gwin, a White House spokesperson, said in an email. "As we rebound from the deep recession caused by the pandemic, it's more important now than ever to put partisanship aside, remove this cloud from over our economy, and responsibly address the debt limit — just like Democrats did three times under the previous administration."

Lieber and other analysts worry party leaders are talking past each other. Experts suggest it would take a week or two for Democratic leaders to steer a debt limit increase through the fast-track budget process. That could leave the government

vulnerable to a sudden crisis. On Friday, the independent Bipartisan Policy Center, a Washington think tank, said the government could run out of cash to pay its bills by mid-October.

Lieber said he is worried about "the risk of miscalculation of both sides," in part because this standoff is not the same as the ones under Obama. "The Republicans aren't asking for anything," he said. "So their position is, there's nothing you can do to get us to vote for a debt ceiling increase. That's a dangerous situation."

Goldman Sachs researchers warned in a note to clients this month that the volatile nature of tax receipts this year, a product of the pandemic, makes the debt limit "riskier than usual" for the economy and markets. They said the standoff was at least as risky as in 2011, when brinkmanship disrupted bond yields and the stock market.

Other financial analysts continue to believe that, as they have in the past, the sides will eventually find an agreement largely because of the consequences of failure.

"We believe Congress will raise or suspend the debt ceiling," Beth Ann Bovino, S&P U.S. chief economist, wrote this week. "A default by the U.S. government would be substantially worse than the collapse of Lehman Brothers in 2008, devastating global markets and the economy."

In the meantime, Republicans are awaiting a vote by Democrats to raise the limit. Sen. Rick Scott of Florida, who heads Republicans' campaign arm in the Senate, told an NBC reporter he was eager to highlight Democratic support for raising the limit in midterm advertisements. America's Need to Pay Its Bills Has Spawned a Political Game

WASHINGTON — For nearly two decades, lawmakers in Washington have waged an escalating display of brinkmanship over the federal government's ability to borrow money to pay its bills. They have forced administrations of both parties to take evasive actions, pushing the nation dangerously close to economic calamity. But they have never actually tipped the United States into default.

The dance is repeating this fall, but this time the dynamics are different — and the threat of default is greater than ever.

Republicans in Congress have refused to help raise the nation's debt limit, even though the need to borrow stems from the bipartisan practice of running large budget deficits. Republicans agree the United States must pay its bills, but on Monday they are expected to block a measure in the Senate that would enable the government to do so. Democrats, insistent that Republicans help pay for past decisions to boost spending and cut taxes, have so far refused to use a special process to raise the limit on their own.

Observers inside and outside Washington are worried neither side will budge in time, roiling financial markets and capsizing the economy's nascent recovery from the pandemic downturn.

If the limit is not raised or suspended, officials at the Treasury Department warn, the government will soon exhaust its ability to borrow money, forcing officials to choose between missing payments on military salaries, Social Security benefits and the interest it owes to investors who have financed America's spending spree.

Yet Republicans have threatened to filibuster any attempt by Senate Democrats to pass a simple bill to increase borrowing. Party leaders like Sen. Mitch McConnell of Kentucky want to force Democrats to raise the limit on their own, through a fast-track congressional process that bypasses a Republican filibuster. That could take weeks to come to fruition, raising the stakes every day that Democratic leaders decline to pursue that option.

The problem is further compounded by the fact that no one is quite sure when the government will run out of money. The COVID-19 pandemic continues to ravage the United States in waves, frequently disrupting economic activity and the taxes the government collects, complicating Treasury's ability to gauge its cash flow. Estimates for what is known as the "X-date" range from as early as Oct. 15 to mid-November.

Amid that uncertainty, congressional leaders and President Joe Biden are not even attempting to negotiate a resolution.

Instead, they are sparring over who should be saddled with a vote that could be used against them, raising the odds that partisan stubbornness will propel the country into a fiscal unknown.

It all adds up to an impasse rooted in political messaging, midterm campaign advertising and a desire by Republican leaders to do whatever they can to protest Biden's economic agenda, including the \$3.5 trillion spending bill that Democrats hope to pass along party lines using a fast-track budget process.

Republicans say they will not supply any votes to lift the debt cap, despite having run up trillions in new debt to pay for the 2017 tax cuts, additional government spending and pandemic aid during the Trump administration. Democrats, in contrast, helped President Donald Trump increase borrowing in 2017 and 2019.

"If they want to tax, borrow, and spend historic sums of money without our input," McConnell said on the Senate floor this week, "they will have to raise the debt limit without our help."

Thus far, Biden and Democratic leaders in Congress have declined to do so, even though employing that process would end the threat of default.

Jon Lieber, a former aide to McConnell who is now with the Eurasia Group, a political-risk consultancy in Washington, wrote in a warning to clients this week that there is a 1-in-5 chance the standoff will push the country into at least a technical debt default — forcing the government to choose between paying bondholders and honoring all its spending commitments — this fall.

"That's crazy high for an event like this," Lieber said in an interview, noting that the odds are significantly higher than in past standoffs. "But I feel really confident that's the level of panic we should be having."

Under President George W. Bush, Democrats, including Biden, voted in 2006 against a debt-limit increase, citing Bush's budget deficits that were swollen by tax cuts and wars in Iraq and Afghanistan. They did so despite warnings from administration officials that a default would hurt the nation's credit rating and economy.

Biden, like many other Democrats, said he could not abet Bush's fiscal decisions. But his party did not filibuster a vote and Republicans were able to pass a debt limit increase along party lines. White House officials say Biden's vote was symbolic, noting that the ability of Republicans to raise the debt ceiling was never in question.

Leaders of both parties have, at times, made a version of the core argument in favor of raising the limit: that it is simply a way to allow the government to pay bills



it has already incurred. Both parties also have shown no sign of slowing the nation's borrowing spree, which accelerated last year as lawmakers approved trillions of dollars of aid for people and businesses struggling through the pandemic recession. Each party has recently occupied the White House and controlled Congress, but neither has come close in recent years to approving a budget that would balance — which is to say, not require additional borrowing and a debt-limit increase — within a decade.

Biden administration officials, former Treasury secretaries from both parties and business executives from around the country have all urged lawmakers to raise the borrowing limit as soon as possible.

"I think it's scary for consumer confidence and for confidence in U.S. businesses and potential credit ratings if we don't make sure that we raise that debt ceiling," Andy Jassy, CEO of Amazon, said on CNBC earlier this month.

Democrats say Republicans have a responsibility to help raise the limit, noting that they helped when Trump needed to do it. White House officials called McConnell's position hypocritical.

"Republicans in Congress have spent a decade ushering in a new era where the prospect of default and a global economic meltdown has become a dangerous political football," Michael Gwin, a White House spokesperson, said in an email. "As we rebound from the deep recession caused by the pandemic, it's more important now than ever to put partisanship aside, remove this cloud from over our economy, and responsibly address the debt limit — just like Democrats did three times under the previous administration."

Lieber and other analysts worry party leaders are talking past each other. Experts suggest it would take a week or two for Democratic leaders to steer a debt limit increase through the fast-track budget process. That could leave the government

vulnerable to a sudden crisis. On Friday, the independent Bipartisan Policy Center, a Washington think tank, said the government could run out of cash to pay its bills by mid-October.

Lieber said he is worried about "the risk of miscalculation of both sides," in part because this standoff is not the same as the ones under Obama. "The Republicans aren't asking for anything," he said. "So their position is, there's nothing you can do to get us to vote for a debt ceiling increase. That's a dangerous situation."

Goldman Sachs researchers warned in a note to clients this month that the volatile nature of tax receipts this year, a product of the pandemic, makes the debt limit "riskier than usual" for the economy and markets. They said the standoff was at least as risky as in 2011, when brinkmanship disrupted bond yields and the stock market.

Other financial analysts continue to believe that, as they have in the past, the sides will eventually find an agreement — largely because of the consequences of failure.

"We believe Congress will raise or suspend the debt ceiling," Beth Ann Bovino, S&P U.S. chief economist, wrote this week. "A default by the U.S. government would be substantially worse than the collapse of Lehman Brothers in 2008, devastating global markets and the economy."

In the meantime, Republicans are awaiting a vote by Democrats to raise the limit. Sen. Rick Scott of Florida, who heads Republicans' campaign arm in the Senate, told an NBC reporter he was eager to highlight Democratic support for raising the limit in midterm advertisements.

Apart from global factors, the expectations of sustained economic recovery, as well as the faster pace of Covid-19 vaccinations in India, have added to the optimism among investors.

"Expectations of solid economic recovery and sustained growth in the next couple of years is keeping the bulls enthused...Having said that, retail investors must have a diversified portfolio at this stage to face any kind of volatility," Sandeep Bharadwaj, CEO, Retail of IIFL Securities said.

Bhardwaj also said that the China Plus One strategy, also known as Plus One, which aims to avoid investing only in China, and diversify the business into other countries, may prove to benefit India going ahead.



What will investors do now? While the tide favors Indian stocks at this point in time, the rising uncertainties should rather not be ignored.

Analysts have been arguing over the extent of the bull run in the domestic indices since February this year—when people acknowledged rising inflation in the US as a problem. When inflation is too high, the Fed typically raises interest rates to slow the economy and bring inflation down.

This has raised the question of when will the rally in global stocks halt.

India's stock valuation premium to its emerging market peers is more than 80% now, which is not likely to sustain, according to analysts. Further, it is feared that corporate earnings in the coming quarters may not justify steep valuations due to rising prices of commodities.

"Investors may think of reducing portfolio risk by moving to the safety of high-quality large-caps," says Dr. V K Vijayakumar, chief investment strategist at Mumbai-based broking firm Geojit Financial Services. "Partial profit booking in the mid and small-cap segment and moving some money to fixed income also may be considered."

Imran Khan paints Pakistan as victim of US ungratefulness

NEW YORK (AP) — Prime Minister Imran Khan sought to cast Pakistan as the victim of American ungratefulness and an international double standard in his address to the United Nations General Assembly on Friday.

In a prerecorded speech aired during the evening, the Pakistani prime minister touched on a range of topics that included climate change, global Islamophobia and "the plunder of the developing world by their corrupt elites" — the latter of which he likened to what the East India Company did to India.

It was for India's government that Khan reserved his harshest words, once again labeling Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi's Hindu nationalist government "fascist." But the cricketer turned posh international celebrity turned politician was in turn indignant and plaintive as he painted the United States as an abandoner of both Pakistan and neighboring Afghanistan.

"For the current situation in Afghanistan, for some reason, Pakistan has been blamed for the turn of events, by politicians in the United States and some politicians in Europe," Khan said. "From this platform, I want them all to know, the country that suffered the most, apart from Afghanistan, was Pakistan when we joined the U.S. war on terror after 9/11."

He launched into a narrative that began with the United States and Pakistan training mujahedeen — regarded as heroes by the likes of then-President Ronald Reagan, he said — during the Soviet occupation of Afghanistan. But Pakistan was left to pick up the pieces — millions of refugees and new sectarian militant groups — when the Soviets and the Americans left in 1989.

Khan said the U.S. sanctioned its former partner a year later, but then came calling again after the 9/11 attacks. Khan said Pakistan's aid to the U.S. cost 80,000 Pakistani lives and caused internal strife and dissent directed at the state, all while the U.S. conducted drone attacks.

"So, when we hear this at the end. There is a lot of worry in the U.S. about taking care of the interpreters and everyone who helped the U.S.," he said, referring to Afghanistan. "What about us?"

Instead of a mere "word of appreciation," Pakistan has received blame, Khan said.

Despite Khan's rhetoric espousing a desire for peace, many Afghans have blamed Pakistan for the Taliban's resurgence in Afghanistan because of close links. The United Nations in August also rejected Pakistan's request to give its side at a special meeting on Afghanistan, indicating the international community's shared skepticism.

In his speech, Khan echoed what his foreign minister, Shah Mehmood Qureshi, told The Associated Press earlier this week on the sidelines at the U.N.: the international community should not isolate the Taliban, but instead strengthen the current Afghan government for the sake of the people.

He struck an optimistic tone about Taliban rule, saying their leaders had committed to human rights, an inclusive government and not allowing terrorists on Afghan soil. But messages from the Taliban have been mixed.

A Taliban founder told the AP earlier this week that the hard-liners would once again carry out executions and amputated hands — though this time after adjudication by judges, including women, and potentially not in public.

"If the world community incentivizes them, and encourages them to walk this talk, it will be a win-win situation for everyone," he said.

Khan also turned his ire on that same community for what he perceives as a free pass given to India.

"It is unfortunate, very unfortunate, that the world's approach to violations of human rights lacks even-handedness, and even is selective. Geopolitical considerations, or corporate interests, commercial interests often compel major powers to overlook the transgressions of their affiliated countries," Khan said.

He went through a litany of actions that have "unleashed a reign of fear and violence against India's 200 million strong Muslim community," he said, including lynchings, pogroms and discriminatory citizenship laws.

As in years past, Khan — who favors delivering his speeches in his Britishinflected English, in contrast to Modi's Hindi addresses — devoted substantial time to Kashmir.

"New Delhi has also embarked on what it ominously calls the 'final solution' for the Jammu and Kashmir dispute," Khan said, rattling off a list of what he termed "gross and systematic violations of human rights" committed by Indian forces. He specifically decried the "forcible snatching of the mortal remains of the great Kashmiri leader, " Syed Ali Geelani, who died



earlier this month at 9

Geelani's family has said authorities took his body and buried him discreetly and without their consent, denying the separatist leader revered in Kashmir a proper Islamic burial. Khan called upon the General Assembly to demand Geelani's proper burial and rites.

Kashmir is divided between India and Pakistan and has been claimed by both since they won independence from the British empire and began fighting over their rival claims.

He said Pakistan desires peace, but it is India's responsibility to meaningfully engage.

India exercised its right of reply after the last leader spoke Friday, saying it was upon Pakistan, not India, to demonstrate good faith in engagement. An Indian diplomat said Pakistan needed to look inward before making accusations, and stressed that Kashmir was inalienably India's. Pakistan then exercised its own right of reply, excoriating India once more.

33 men accused of gang-raping teen girl over eight months in India

Police in India have arrested more than two dozen men accused of gang-raping a 15-year-old girl multiple times over a period of nearly eight months — a horrific ordeal that ended when the victim finally came forward this week.

The number of people charged in the case went up to 29 on Friday after police nabbed three more suspects, according to multiple reports. Cops are on the hunt for four more men as the girl has named 33 alleged rapists, including at least two minors, the Hindustan Times reported.

The teen told investigators that the abuse began on Jan. 29 and continued until Wednesday, when she told an aunt who then filed a report on her behalf. The attacks happened in multiple locations, including her hometown of Dombivli, which is next to Mumbai, she reportedly

told police.

The girl said it all began when a man she was in a relationship with threatened to leak a private video of the couple unless she engaged in sexual acts with some of his friends and acquaintances, according to reports. The group then raped her on multiple occasions throughout the year, she said.

It was not immediately clear if her former partner was among the 29 suspects already in custody.

The shocking allegations sparked widespread condemnation in Dombivli, which is reportedly seeing a rise in violence against women, and across the country. Nelson Oliveira, New York Daily News Yahoo News



Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdoğan said in an exclusive interview with CBS News this week that his government intends to defy the U.S. and go ahead with the purchase of another Russianmade anti-aircraft missile defense system, despite repeated warnings that it puts the security of the NATO alliance at risk.

Erdoğan confirmed his plans to CBS News chief foreign affairs correspondent Margaret Brennan after she asked him about Russian government claims that Turkey would purchase more S-400 systems.

"I explained everything to President Biden," Erdoğan said in an interview taped Tuesday on the sidelines of the U.N. General Assembly in New York, claiming that America's refusal to sell Turkey the U.S.-made Patriots system as an alternative had led his government to purchase the Russian system instead. The U.S. has disputed this claim.

Both the Trump and Biden administrations have maintained that the Russian S-400 system is a danger if activated in the same country that flies F-35 jets. The U.S. government has said the S-400 would collect detailed information about the F-35s, possibly erasing their stealth advantages. Turkey had previously bought F-35 jets, which gave the NATO member a role in their production. But in retaliation for Turkey's S-400 purchase, the Trump administration halted its delivery of the F-35s, dropped Turkey from the program and imposed sanctions on Turkish defense officials.

Despite this, Erdoğan has remained defi-

"So it sounds like you still intend to buy another round of these S-400s, of these Russian missile systems?" Brennan asked. "So the sanctions will stay on?"

"In the future, nobody will be able to interfere in terms of what kind of defense systems we acquire, from which country, at what level. Nobody can interfere with that. We are the only ones to make such decisions," Erdogan responded.

"That sounds like a yes." Brennan said.

"Of course, of course, yes," Erdoğan said. He later confirmed that he plans to meet with Russian President Vladimir Putin at the end of the month. The two are expected to discuss a number of issues, including Syria.

During the interview, Erdoğan also told CBS News that he would prefer that the U.S. pull out its remaining 900 troops in neighboring Syria. Turkey's forces have remained in the northern part of the country since its military incursion to fight U.S.-allied Kurdish forces, after former President Donald Trump attempted to withdraw all U.S. troops in the fall of 2019.

This is just one of many irritants in the relationship between the U.S. and Turkey, which remains a key power in the Middle East and a NATO member. As a presidential candidate, Mr. Biden told The New York Times' editorial board in January 2020 that Erdoğan was "an autocrat," and cited his expansive powers and abuse of power. Erdoğan seemed to brush off the

"Mr. President's definition of an autocrat remains unknown to me, I don't know what he meant," Erdoğan told Brennan. He also said that Mr. Biden has never raised any concern about human rights abuse issues to him during their personal conversations. National Security Council spokeswoman Emily Horne did not return CBS News' request for comment.

As per the Committee for the Protection of Journalists' 2020 worldwide ranking index, Turkey is the second worst jailer of journalists — second only to China – and worse than Iran and Saudi Arabia. Erdoğan's government also arrested and charged some 36,000 people in Turkey whom it accused of criticizing him or being connected to figures it believes were responsible for the attempted coup to overthrow him in 2016.

Mr. Biden last met with Erdoğan in Brussels this past June. At the time, it appeared there might be an opportunity for a breakthrough in the troubled relationship. Erdoğan told CBS News that it was Mr. Biden who asked him to consider having Turkish forces run the airport in Kabul in the wake of the U.S. withdrawal. It was a key opportunity, and Erdoğan said he was open to the idea on the condition of logistical and financial support.

"It's including financial and equipment support, the ammunitions, the vehicles and the weapons there would have been transferred to us. But such things have unfolded that the exact opposite happened," Erdoğan said.



The U.S. withdrawal and the chaotic way i was carried out left NATO troops scrambling as well. Turkey, which has the second largest army in NATO, also pulled out of the country.

"The artillery, the ammunition, the weapons and the vehicles at the Karzai airport were all transferred over to the Taliban, and the Taliban is currently using all those weapons and all those vehicles, and we have to see all these facts for what they are," he said.

Since the Taliban seized control of Afghanistan last month, both Oatar and Turkey have offered to provide technical support to their emerging government in order to keep their airports operating. That provided Turkey with the chance to be a power broker and essentially provide the Taliban with a lifeline to the rest of the world. Erdoğan said that at this point, there is no deal to work with the Taliban.

In an interview that will air on Sunday's "Face the Nation," Erdoğan laid out what he described as his requirements to do business with the Taliban. Margaret Brennan Yahoo News

UAE announces ministerial changes including finance, environment

RIYADH (Reuters) -United Arab Emirates Prime Minister and Dubai ruler Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum announced ministerial changes including new finance and environment ministers.

Sheikh Maktoum bin Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum -- Sheikh Mohammed's son and the current deputy ruler of Dubai -- has been appointed deputy prime minister and finance minister.

Mohammed bin Hadi Al Husseini replaces long-serving Obaid Humaid Al Tayer as the Emirates' minister of state for finance, while Maryam Al Muhairi becomes the minister of climate change and environment.

Suhail Mohamed Al Mazrouei remains energy minister, but also takes on the role of infrastucture minister reflecting the merger of both ministries.

Sheikh Mohammed announced the reshuffle as part of a new government strategy aimed at expediting change through "transformational projects" in the Emirates.

"The new strategy comes with the completion of our previous plan, UAE Vision 2021, through which we achieved all our ambitions in the past 10 years," he said on Twitter.

The announcement comes as Gulf countries seek to secure investment and boost their international status as the importance of oil declines.

The UAE recently announced plans to launch 50 new economic initiatives to boost the country's competitiveness and attract 550 billion dirhams (\$150 billion) in foreign direct investment in the next nine years.



The Gulf state has launched several measures over the past year to attract investment and foreigners to help the economy recover from the effects of the pandemic. The changes also come amid a growing economic rivalry with Gulf neighbour Saudi Arabia to be the region's trade and business hub.

British and Malaysian men jailed in Somalia for terror offences

British man Darren Anthony Byrnes was one of two foreigners to be sentenced to 15 years by a military court in Somalia for belonging to Islamist militant group al-Shabab.

Byrnes and Malaysian Ahmad Mustakim bin Abdul Hamid were convicted of recruiting foreigners.

Al-Shabab has been battling Somalia's UNbacked government for over a decade.

The al-Qaeda-linked group has also carried out attacks in neighbouring Kenya.

The two men denied being members of al-Shabab and the prosecution did not call any witnesses in court but relied on written accounts, their lawyer told Voice of America.

They have 30 days to appeal.

Byrnes came to Somalia "to shed blood", prosecutor Brig Gen Abdullahi Bule

Kamay said in a video extract of the court proceedings released by the military.

"If he is spreading Islam, why did he not do that in the UK?" he added.

The prosecution said that Byrnes had converted to Islam in 2006. He then travelled to Mombasa, on Kenya's coast, where he married a Somali woman.

He crossed into Somalia in 2010, according to the prosecution.

Byrnes told the court in the capital, Mogadishu, that when he entered the country he came across some Kenyan soldiers, who were part of an African Union force supporting the government.

"They asked me where I am going. I said: 'I am going to Mogadishu to visit my fam-

"They took \$50 (£36) from me, I presumed that was my visa. End of story."

Along with Abdul Hamid, Byrnes was accused of using the internet to encourage other foreigners to join al-Shabab.

The prosecution alleged that they had tried to recruit cells to carry out an attack in Paris, France, but gave no further details on when or how.

The two men were captured in 2019 while trying to board a boat to Yemen.

In a brief statement, the British embassy in Mogadishu said it was "providing consular assistance" to Byrnes "and are offering support to his family".

It would not comment on what happened

Al-Shabab emerged about 15 years ago to support the Union of Islamic Courts, which controlled Mogadishu in 2006.

has waged an insurgency ever since.

Al-Shabab carries out frequent bombing attacks in urban areas, often targeting hotels and restaurants, as well as government buildings.

In Kenya, its fighters killed at least 67 people in a 2013 attack on the Westgate shopping centre in the capital, Nairobi. Two years later, it targeted a university in Garissa, in the east of the country, where nearly 150 people were killed. Yahoo News



Turkey's Erdogan looks to Putin after Biden talks disappoint

ISTANBUL (AP) — Turkish President Recep Tayyip Erdogan said Friday that recent talks with U.S. President Joe Biden had proved disappointing, and that his country, a NATO member, would seek closer ties with Russia.

Speaking after prayers in Istanbul, Erdogan said he and Biden had failed to bridge their differences at a meeting during his visit to New York for the UN General Assembly this week.

"In the discussions with Mr. Biden that I'd been anticipating, there wasn't the desired outcome. ... As two NATO countries, we need to be at a different point," he told journalists.

Erdogan went on to criticize U.S. support Russia is the main ally of the Syrian

for Kurdish militants in Syria who were instrumental in fighting the Islamic State group. Ankara considers them terrorists due to their links to the Kurdistan Workers' Party, or PKK, which has waged a 37-year insurgency against Turkey. Turkey has a large and restive Kurdish ethnic minority. The PKK is listed as a terrorist organization by the U.S. and EU.

"America is not fighting terrorist organizations enough, it is giving them a lot of weapons and equipment," he said.

Erdogan is due to meet Russian President Vladimir Putin in the Black Sea resort of Sochi on Sept. 29, where the leaders will concentrate on the situation in Syria.

government while Turkey supports groups that have fought to unseat President Bashar Assad. However, Russian and Turkish troops have cooperated in Idlib, the final holdout of rebel forces, and in seeking a political solution in the war-torn country.

JERUSALEM (AP) — In an unusually harsh speech, President Mahmoud Abbas on Friday gave Israel one year to end its occupation of territories the Palestinians want for a future state. He threatened to withdraw recognition of Israel — a cornerstone of three decades of failed peace efforts — if it failed to do so.

Abbas delivered the vague ultimatum in a long, prerecorded address to the U.N. General Assembly in which he accused Israel of "apartheid" and "ethnic cleansing," explosive terms rarely employed by the 85-year-old leader, who has long been committed to a two-state solution.

"If the Israeli occupation authorities continue to entrench the reality of one apartheid state as is happening today, our Palestinian people and the entire world will not tolerate such a situation," Abbas said. "Circumstances on the ground will inevitably impose equal and full political rights for all on the land of historical Palestine, within one state."

A one-state solution, while popular with some Israeli and Palestinian activists, would mean the end of Israel as a Jewishmajority state. No major Israeli or Palestinian party supports such an outcome.

Abbas spoke against a backdrop showing the Al-Aqsa mosque in Jerusalem, a flashpoint holy site sacred to Muslims and Jews, and a series of maps of the region showing Israel's territorial expansion over several decades of war and conflict.

He said he was willing to negotiate final borders over the coming year but that if Israel did not ultimately end its occupation of territories seized in the 1967 war, then he would reconsider recognition of Israel.

"If this is not achieved, why maintain recognition of Israel based on the 1967 borders?" Abbas said. He also threatened to confront Israel at the International Court of Justice.

Israel's ambassador to the U.N. said Abbas had "proved once again that he is no longer relevant."

"Those who truly support peace and negotiations do not threaten delusional ultimatums from the U.N. platform as he did in his speech," Gilad Erdan said in a

Israel captured the West Bank, east Jerusalem and Gaza in the 1967 war with neighboring Arab countries, territories the Palestinians want for their future state. It annexed east Jerusalem in a move not internationally recognized and withdrew its forces from Gaza in 2005. The Islamic militant group Hamas won parliamentary elections a year later and seized Gaza from Abbas' forces in a bloody power struggle in 2007.

Israel has made various offers over the years that it says would have given the Palestinians independence in most of the territories. But the Palestinians — always the weaker negotiating party - said each proposal fell short of granting them full statehood and resolving other core

issues, like the fate of Palestinian refugees and the status of Jerusalem.

Palestinian recognition of Israel was the foundation of the 1993 Oslo accords that launched the Middle East peace process. Talks ground to a halt more than a decade ago, and Israel's current prime minister, Naftali Bennett, is opposed to the creation of a Palestinian state alongside Israel,

which is still widely seen internationally as the only way to resolve the conflict.

Abbas' harsh rhetoric reflects widespread Palestinian frustration with the moribund peace process. But it could also be seen as a way of burnishing his nationalist credentials at home, where he faces a major backlash from Palestinians frustrated by his long rule and the increasingly authoritarian Palestinian Authority.

A poll released this week found that nearly 80% of Palestinians want him to resign. Abbas' presidential mandate expired in 2009, but he has continued as head of the PA, which administers parts of the Israelioccupied West Bank.

Abbas canceled the first Palestinian elections in 15 years back in April when it appeared his Fatah party would suffer an embarrassing loss. He was largely sidelined during the 11-day Gaza war in May, when support for his militant Hamas rivals soared.



The death of a prominent critic of the PA while in the custody of Palestinian security forces in June sparked widespread protests in which the security forces beat and arrested several demonstrators.

But Abbas is still viewed internationally as the representative of the Palestinian cause and a vital partner in the peace process. His forces coordinate security with Israel, targeting Hamas and other militant groups that both view as a threat — a policy that has contributed to his unpopularity.

Abbas has made veiled threats before, and is unlikely to follow through with the kind of drastic political decision that would spell the end of the PA, which was created through the Oslo accords. His government also relies heavily on aid from the international community, which remains committed to a negotiated two-state solution. JOSEPH KRAUSS Yahoo News

Mr Modi congratulated Ms Harris on her historic position and invited her to return

"The people of India are waiting to welcome you," he said.

In November, residents of Ms Harris' ancestral village, Thulasendrapuram, in India's south, lit fireworks and marched in the street following news of her win.

Mr Modi's three-day trip ends on Friday, capped by his first meeting with President Joe Biden.

Speaking in the Oval Office, Mr Biden

extended a warm welcome to Mr Modi and paid tribute to the four million Indian Americans who he said "make us stronger".

Mr Modi returned the well wishes, saying the bilateral meeting was sowing the seeds "for an even stronger friendship between India and the US".

Islamic fundamentals aimed at ensuring total health, family peace and social order -Dr Javid Jamil

Islamic fundamentals aimed at ensuring total health, family peace and social order: On 25th September, 2021, I was invited as one of the main speakers in a two day conference organised by the Karnataka Jamaat Islami Hind at Mangalore. The conference was on the subject of "Inviting towards God through Wisdom", which was attended by several hundred people from across the state. I was requested to deliver a talk as on "Atheism, Contemporary Ideologies and The Rationality of the Fundamentals of Islam". It was almost a two hour long session. First, I spoke for around 50 minutes, which was followed by an extremely lively interactive session during which around a dozen questions were asked. In fact if time had permitted it could have gone much longer. In my talk, I argued that there is an urgent need to focus on the ways to challenge the so called modern ideologies that are posing huge threat to health, family peace and social order with ever rising crime rates including lakhs of murders and rapes, millions of deaths due to alcohol, free sex which has resulted in more than 37 million deaths due to AIDS in last 30 years,, more than 5 crore (50 million) abortions every year and tens of thousands of suicides including those due to gambling etc. The whole legal system, healthcare system and family system are in doldrums. In Western countries, more than 40 pc children are born out of wedlock and more than 60 pc children are living with single parents, mostly mothers (figures about America and Europe). Women and children are the biggest sufferers. All this is done for the benefit of the market forces and all the evils have become big businesses today. They first commercialize the causes of the problems and then the solutions of the problems. Economic fundamentalism is the primary ideology behind all the developments in every field -- law, education, sciences, social order, politics, and what not. "Freedom" in today's world means nothing but freedom to engage in activities that bring money to the market despite the undeniable facts that they cause huge health and peace issues.

I stressed the need to use facts and figures to highlight how Islamic system is health and peace protective. I told that Islamic system has three tiers, individual, family and society and Islam has three dimensional legal system comprising Fundamental Rights, Fundamental Duties and Fundamental Prohibitions. All the commands of Islam are aimed at ensuring health and peace at every level. Even measures like circumcision play extremely important role in preventing AIDS and other sex transmitted diseases as well as in minimising the risks of cancers of penis and cervix in females who are their wives.

I also dwelt upon the huge failure of the modern legal system. The crime rates including murderous assaults and rapes are maximum in those countries which claim to be most advanced and civilized including America and Europe. Despite tens of millions of police men, hundreds of thousands of lawyers, tens of thousands of judges, crime rates are zooming. Both the parties of lawyers are normally engaged in distortion or exaggeration of facts and yet judges are supposed to give judgment on the basis of their arguments.

In reply to a question, I told that almost all the major epidemics since the beginning of the Twentieth Century have association with noncompliance of the Islamic guidelines. Spanish Flu and Swine Flu have killed more than 180 million (!8 cr) people in last 110 years, and most scientists believe that the pig farming necessitated by pork eating was the ultimate cause. HIV/AIDS, due to indulgence in promiscuity, homosexuality and drugs killed around 38 million (3.8 cr) people. Corona too, according to most researchers, came through the meat of penguins and bats, which are not allowed in Islam. Further, if the Prophetic (SAW) Hadith regarding Epidemics had been followed, it could not have spread outside Wuhan, or at the most outside China. The Hadith advised that if



an epidemic spreads anywhere, the people from that area must not leave it and people from outside must not enter it. 11 foods that lower cholesterol

Changing what foods you eat can lower your cholesterol and improve the armada of fats floating through your bloodstream. Adding foods that lower LDL, the harmful cholesterol-carrying particle that contributes to artery-clogging atherosclerosis, is the best way to achieve a low cholesterol

Add these foods to lower LDL cholesterol

Different foods lower cholesterol in various ways. Some deliver soluble fiber, which binds cholesterol and its precursors in the digestive system and drags them out of the body before they get into circulation. Some give you polyunsaturated fats, which directly lower LDL. And some contain plant sterols and stanols, which block the body from absorbing cholesterol.

- 1. Oats. An easy first step to lowering your cholesterol is having a bowl of oatmeal or cold oat-based cereal like Cheerios for breakfast. It gives you 1 to 2 grams of soluble fiber. Add a banana or some strawberries for another half-gram. Current nutrition guidelines recommend getting 20 to 35 grams of fiber a day, with at least 5 to 10 grams coming from soluble fiber. (The average American gets about half that amount.)
- 2. Barley and other whole grains. Like oats and oat bran, barley and other whole grains can help lower the risk of heart disease, mainly via the soluble fiber they deliver.
- 3. Beans. Beans are especially rich in soluble fiber. They also take a while for the body to digest, meaning you feel full for longer after a meal. That's one reason beans are a useful food for folks trying to lose weight. With so many choices — from navy and kidney beans to lentils, garbanzos, black-eyed peas, and beyond — and so many ways to prepare them, beans are a

very versatile food.

Foods that make up a low cholesterol diet can help reduce high levels

Changing what foods you eat can lower your cholesterol and improve the armada of fats floating through your bloodstream. Adding foods that lower LDL, the harmful cholesterol-carrying particle that contributes to artery-clogging atherosclerosis, is the best way to achieve a low cholesterol diet.. Eggplant and okra. These two low-calorie vegetables are good sources of soluble fiber.

- 5. Nuts. A bushel of studies shows that eating almonds, walnuts, peanuts, and other nuts is good for the heart. Eating 2 ounces of nuts a day can slightly lower LDL, on the order of 5%. Nuts have additional nutrients that protect the heart in other ways.
- 6. Vegetable oils. Using liquid vegetable oils such as canola, sunflower, safflower, and others in place of butter, lard, or shortening when cooking or at the table helps lower LDL.
- 7. Apples, grapes, strawberries, citrus fruits. These fruits are rich in pectin, a type of soluble fiber that lowers LDL.
- 8. Foods fortified with sterols and stanols. Sterols and stanols extracted from plants gum up the body's ability to absorb cholesterol from food. Companies are adding them to foods ranging from margarine and granola bars to orange juice and chocolate. They're also available as supplements. Getting 2 grams of plant sterols or stanols a day can lower LDL cholesterol by about 10%.
- 9. Soy. Eating soybeans and foods made from them, like tofu and soy milk, was once touted as a powerful way to lower cholesterol. Analyses show that the effect is more modest — consuming 25 grams of soy protein a day (10 ounces of tofu or 2



1/2 cups of soy milk) can lower LDL by 5%

- 10. Fatty fish. Eating fish two or three times a week can lower LDL in two ways: by replacing meat, which has LDL-boosting saturated fats, and by delivering LDLlowering omega-3 fats. Omega-3s reduce triglycerides in the bloodstream and also protect the heart by helping prevent the onset of abnormal heart rhythms.
- 11. Fiber supplements. Supplements offer the least appealing way to get soluble fiber. Two teaspoons a day of psyllium, which is found in Metamucil and other bulkforming laxatives, provide about 4 grams of soluble fiber.

Putting together a low cholesterol diet When it comes to investing money, experts recommend creating a portfolio of diverse investments instead of putting all your eggs in one basket. The same holds true for eating your way to lower cholesterol. Adding several foods to lower cholesterol in different ways should work better than focusing on one or two.

A largely vegetarian "dietary portfolio of

cholesterol-lowering foods" substantially lowers LDL, triglycerides, and blood pressure. The key dietary components are plenty of fruits and vegetables, whole grains instead of highly refined ones, and protein mostly from plants. Add margarine enriched with plant sterols; oats, barley, psyllium, okra, and eggplant, all rich in soluble fiber; soy protein; and whole almonds.

Of course, shifting to a cholesterol-lowering diet takes more attention than popping a daily statin. It means expanding the variety of foods you usually put in your shopping cart and getting used to new textures and flavors. But it's a "natural" way to lower cholesterol, and it avoids the risk of muscle problems and other side effects that plague some people who take statins.

Just as important, a diet that is heavy on fruits, vegetables, beans, and nuts is good for the body in ways beyond lowering cholesterol. It keeps blood pressure in check. It helps arteries stay flexible and responsive. It's good for bones and digestive health, for vision and mental health.

Healthy eating for blood sugar control

If you have diabetes, a healthy eating plan for you is not that different from a healthy eating plan for people without diabetes. The American Diabetes Association (ADA) echoes the dietary guidelines recommended for the general public that is, a diet centered on fruits, vegetables, whole grains, legumes (peas and beans), and low-fat dairy products.

However, you'll want to pay special attention to your carbohydrate intake Vegetables, fruits, and whole grains provide more nutrition per calorie than refined carbohydrates and tend to be rich in fiber. Your body digests high-fiber foods more slowly — which means a more moderate rise in blood sugar.

For most people with diabetes, carbohydrates should account for about 45% to 55% of the total calories you eat each day. Choose your carbohydrates wisely — ideally, from vegetables, whole grains, and fruits. Avoid highly refined carbohydrates such as white bread, pasta, and rice, as well as candy, sugary soft drinks, and sweets. Refined carbohydrates tend to cause sharp spikes in blood sugar, and can boost blood triglyceride levels.

Fiber comes in two forms: insoluble fiber, the kind found in whole grains, and soluble fiber, found in beans, dried peas, oats, and fruits. Soluble fiber in particular appears to lower blood sugar levels by improving insulin sensitivity, which may mean you need less diabetes medicine. And a number of studies suggest that eating plenty of fiber reduces the chances of developing heart disease — and people with diabetes need to do all they can to lower their risk. Blood sugar levels above the normal range are actually toxic to your cells. Left untreated or even poorly controlled, diabetes can lead to heart disease, vision loss, kidney failure, stroke, loss of limbs and more. And the risk of diabetes increases with age.

India's Modi targets neighbors at UN, but not by name

NEW YORK (AP) — Indian Prime Minister Narendra Modi didn't directly mention Pakistan or China in his Saturday speech to the United Nations General Assembly, but the targets of his address were clear.

In a roughly 20-minute speech delivered in-person and in Hindi, he called upon the international community to help the women, children and minorities of Afghanistan and said that it was imperative the country not be used as a base from which to spread terror.

"We also need to be alert and ensure that no country tries to take advantage of the delicate situation there, and use it as a tool for its own selfish interests," he said in an apparent reference to Pakistan, wedged between Afghanistan and India.

India has charged that the Taliban is Pakistan's "proxy terrorist" group and expressed concerns that Afghanistan could be used as a training ground for anti-India militant groups. The government in New Delhi also worries that the Taliban takeover could strengthen insurgency in the disputed region of Kashmir, which both India and Pakistan claim in full.

Modi did not mention Kashmir or the long-simmering conflict there, in contrast to Pakistani Prime Minister Imran Khan's speech the previous evening.

Modi also highlighted what he called the need to protect oceans from "the race for expansion and exclusion." India and China

have long competed for influence in the Indian Ocean.

Modi's speech came a day after the prime minister met one-on-one with President Joe Biden and participated in a summit of "the Quad": the U.S., Japan, India and Australia. The members of the informal Indo-Pacific alliance have been uneasy as China's power grows in the region.

On the heels of waves of coronavirus surges that have ravaged India, Modi made no mention of his own country's death toll — one that experts believe numbers in the millions. But he reaffirmed last week's announcement that India would restart exporting vaccines next month.

India paused its export of vaccines in April after donating or selling 66 million doses to nearly 100 countries. The halt, amid an overwhelming virus surge, left many developing countries without adequate supply as India was expected to be a key supplier.

"Deeply conscious of its responsibility towards mankind, India has resumed the process of providing vaccines to those who need it in the world," Modi said, inviting vaccine manufacturers to come to India and touting Indian scientists' advances.

Modi's elision of direct references to China, Pakistan or Indian coronavirus casualties isn't exactly new. It was the same story at last year's U.N. General Assembly, when amid border tensions with Pakistan

and China and an already high death toll, he opted to instead paint India as a country that treats "the whole world as one family" and promoted domestic initiatives.

Modi also reiterated last year's criticism of the United Nations, saying it was incumbent on the international body to

strengthen its own effectiveness and boost its credibility.

"Today, all kinds of questions have been raised about the U.N.," he said. "We have seen such questions being raised related to the climate crisis. And we also saw that during COVID, the proxy war going on in many parts of the world, terrorism, and the recent Afghan crisis have further highlighted the seriousness of these questions."

India has long pushed for a permanent seat on the Security Council, the most powerful organ of the United Nations. Earlier in his speech, Modi referenced India's global influence by underscoring that "every sixth person in the world is Indian."

"When India grows, the world grows. When India reforms, the world transforms," he said.

While Modi struck a high-minded tone in his speech, India and Pakistan verbally sparred during Friday night's "right of reply" period. Following Khan's speech in which he accused India of human rights



abuses and fomenting terrorism, an Indian diplomat essentially flung those same accusations back.

Khan had also accused Modi's hardline, Hindu nationalist government of propagating Islamophobia. Modi did not respond to that charge Saturday morning, but broadly proclaimed India's pluralism.

"Our diversity is the identity of our strong democracy," he said. "It is a country that has dozens of languages. Hundreds of dialects, different lifestyles and cuisines. This is the best example of a vibrant democracy."

Less than an hour after Modi's speech concluded, a coalition of groups outside the United Nations building protested what organizers described as "the Modi government's assault on human rights, secular democracy, and persecution of religious minorities, Dalits, and farmers in India." In rural Afghanistan, a family welcomes Taliban rule

The interior of the house made of mud bricks was cool, clean and calm. A man called Shamsullah, who had a small son clinging to his leg, ushered his visitors into the room where they received guests.

A rug covered the floor and cushions ran along the walls that were at least two-feet thick. A few treasures were on display. A small cabinet with half a dozen tiny coloured glass bottles. But the family are poor, and any possessions they had were destroyed or looted during the last 20 years of war.

The house was a refuge from the hot sun and dusty air outside. It was surrounded by high mud walls, like all the family compounds in the fields that became battlefields in Marjah, Helmand province. Inside the walls they were ready to harvest a few more puffballs of cotton to be added to the bale Shamsullah had already taken from the fields outside.

Shamsullah ushered in his mother, Goljuma. He said she was 65. She had wrapped herself in a long shawl that covered her head and body down to her knees, with a small gap so she could peer out.

Sometimes I caught the flash of an eye and the bridge of a nose. Goljuma's voice was strong as she talked about a life full of sadness and a war that destroyed her life and killed her four eldest sons. Shamsullah, the youngest, was the only one left. He was 24, but his face was 10 years older.

Goljuma's first son to die, 11 years ago, was Zia Ul Huq. He was a fighter for the Taliban. "My son joined the Taliban because he understood that the Americans wanted to destroy Islam and Afghanistan," she said.

The other three sons died within a few months in 2014. Quadratallah was killed in an air strike. Two other brothers, Hayatullah and Aminullah, were arrested in a police raid on the family home. Shamsullah said his brothers were forced to sign up for the army, where they were killed. As the only survivor, Shamsullah said God decided he had to take on the responsibilities of the family.

"Have you ever tried to balance five water melons on one hand? That's how it is for me," he told me. His duties include ensuring the welfare of the widow of his oldest brother, Zia, the Taliban fighter.

"I miss my brothers," Shamsullah said.
"My eldest brother's wife married my
next brother when he died. When he
was killed, my next brother married
her. When he was killed my fourth
brother married her. I married her
when he was killed."

In 2010, Marjah was chosen as the first set piece operation of the US troop "surge" ordered by President Barack Obama. The idea was that reinforcements would deliver knockout blows that would change the course of the war decisively in favour of the government in Kabul and the American, British and other allied forces that sustained it.

"As we push the Taliban out, there is nothing but a bright future ahead: good schools, good health clinics, a free-flowing market," a US military press release that year predicted.

The fields of cotton and opium poppies in Marjah turned into a nightmare for the foreign troops that fought the elusive Taliban insurgents. Three months into the long drawn-out operation the US Commander General Stanley McChrystal called Marjah "a bleeding ulcer". It was fought over many times in the next 10 years.

Goljuma was contemptuous of Western leaders who said they were trying to make Afghanistan a better place for the people. "I don't know anything about their mission. They destroyed the country," she said.

She was incredulous when I asked her about the opportunities that women were able to take and now are heart-broken to lose. "So many of our people suffered a lot while they were here. They killed our husbands, our brothers and our sons," she said. "I like the Taliban because they respect Islam. Women like me are not like women in Kabul."

She said before the Taliban won the war everyone was scared of them. Now they are relieved it is over.

One question, however, is whether she was speaking freely. The Taliban media



office insisted the BBC team travelled with an armed Talib bodyguard and a translator it approved as a condition of our presence in Helmand. If they had not been there, we might have heard more about the fear the Taliban drilled into many Afghans.

But I did not doubt Goljuma's sincerity when she condemned the destruction inflicted on Helmand's traditional farming community by the world's most powerful militaries, and her grief about her four dead sons.

In 2001, shortly after the 9/11 attacks on America the US, the UK and their allies invaded Afghanistan with a clear mission: to destroy al-Qaeda and punish the Taliban for harbouring them.

It is what happened next that is much harder to understand and to justify; an unwinnable war that cut across all that they tried to do to improve the lives of Afghans.

Development, like democracy, cannot come from the barrel of a gun. The West had victories along the way. Indeed, a generation of urban men and women were educated and had their horizons transformed. But those benefits did not reach poor and barely

educated people in the countryside like Goljuma's family.

When the Taliban first seized power in 1996, they used violence to enforce their religious and cultural beliefs. Now, most Afghans are too young to remember the years before 9/11 and the invasion.

In Lashkar Gah, young Talibs reacted to the BBC cameras by taking out their mobile phones, filming us and taking selfies with the foreigners. Mobile data is cheap here; our Taliban escort watched BBC Pashto on his phone. The world is open to them in a way that it wasn't in the 1990s, when the Taliban banned photography.

Their group's fighters are no longer boys who grew up with no knowledge of the outside world. So will they force their own fighters, let alone the rest of the population, to give up smartphones, the internet and a world that beckons them on? His country mired in crises, Lebanese leader calls for help

BEIRUT (AP) — The reverberations of terrorism across the oceans and war in their own neighborhood have left Lebanon and its fellow nations in the Middle East struggling with the consequences, Lebanon's president said Friday, calling for international help to save his own crisishit country.

With Lebanon mired in an unprecedented economic and financial meltdown, President Michel Aoun told the U.N. General Assembly's meeting of world leaders that the country could not rise without assistance from the global community.

Lebanon is in the grips of multiple crises that exploded in succession beginning in late 2019, largely caused by decades of corruption and mismanagement by the country's ruling class. A currency crash has plunged about three quarters of the population into poverty in the past year and triggered a brain drain not seen since its 1975-90 civil war days.

That has been accelerated by the coronavirus pandemic and a massive explosion at the port of Beirut in August 2020 that killed more than 200 people and destroyed

parts of the city. Hundreds of thousands of refugees from neighboring Syria have put an additional strain on the tiny Mediterranean country.

The international community has refused to offer financial assistance before Lebanese leaders undertake critical reforms and stamp out endemic corruption.

Aoun described the recent formation of a new government in Lebanon after more than a year of political paralysis a "promising step on the road to recovery," and appealed for the world's help.

"We now look to the international community to finance vital projects in the public and private sectors in order to revive the economy and create job opportunities,"

Aoun also said Lebanon welcomes any international effort to rehabilitate and develop Beirut's port following the catastrophic Aug. 4. 2020 explosion. The blast happened when a fire ignited hundreds of tons of ammonium nitrates that had been haphazardly stored for years at a port

A year later, no one has been held accountable and it is still not clear who brought the ammoniums to the country and why they were stored there for so long in a rotting state. Families of the victims and many other Lebanese have demanded an international investigation, accusing Lebanese authorities of blocking the internal probe.

"Today, after more than a year has passed, our capital is still dark and (Beirut) is still a stricken city." Aoun said.

He said he was determined to undertake the necessary reforms by working with the new government headed by billionaire businessman Najib Mikati that was formed earlier this month. He also called for assistance from Western countries to help Lebanon "bear the burdens of the displaced" and guarantee their safe return to Syria, rejecting their permanent resettlement in Lebanon.

Lebanon has a population of about 6 million people, including 1 million Syrian refugees. That's the highest per-capita proportion of refugees in the world.

Aoun said the Middle East region "paid a high price" in death, destruction and displacement as a result of the war on terror that followed the 9/11 attacks in New York 20 years ago. In his prerecorded speech, Aoun said nations in the Mideast region today are healing their wounds and "trying \overline{\Omega} to rise as New York rose before, because the will to live remains stronger than any terrorism." Omar one of few voting no on Iron Dome defense funding

U.S. Rep. Ilhan Omar bucked most of her fellow House Democrats this week as one of only nine members to oppose \$1 billion for Israel's Iron Dome defense system.

Omar, a defender of Palestinian human rights and prominent Congressional critic of Israel's government, has faced bipartisan controversy when it comes to Israel during her time in office.

Omar declined a request for an interview on Friday, but in a series of tweets ahead of Thursday's vote, the Minnesota Democrat said that "given the human rights violations in Gaza, Sheikh Jarrah, and evergrowing settlement expansion, we should not be ramming through a last-minute \$1 billion increase in military funding for Israel without any accountability." She added in a later tweet, "we continue to pay lip service to human rights, peace and a two state solution. Yet we also continue to provide Israel with funding without addressing the underlying issue of the occupation."

While one Republican and a few other progressives in the group known as the "Squad" also voted no on the bill Thursday, the House overwhelmingly passed the money by a vote of 420 to 9. Omar's vote was sharply criticized by Steve Hunegs, executive director of the Jewish Community Relations Council of Minnesota and the Dakotas (JCRC). "The unfortunate no vote of Representative Omar repudiates in starkest terms essential life or death protection for all who live in Israel," Hunegs

But Lana Barkawi, a Palestinian American

and executive director of the arts organization Mizna, defended Omar's vote. Barkawi, a Minneapolis resident who has donated to Omar's campaign and appeared with her at a 2019 news conference after Israel denied Omar entry to the country, said "it was really important to take the stand that she took and I know that there are Palestinians and allies across her district who feel the same way."

The decision put Omar at odds with the rest of Minnesota's U.S. House delegation. All four Republicans and Minnesota's three other Democrats in the chamber voted in support of the legislation.

"The Iron Dome defense system has saved many innocent lives, and I was proud to join my colleagues on both sides of the aisle to approve its continued funding this week," Democratic U.S. Rep. Angie Craig said in a statement.

During her first term, Omar apologized after House Democratic leadership condemned her remarks, saying her "use of anti-Semitic tropes and prejudicial accusations about Israel's supporters is deeply offensive." Earlier this year, Omar tweeted "we have seen unthinkable atrocities committed by the U.S., Hamas, Israel, Afghanistan, and the Taliban," in reference to an exchange involving the International Criminal Court during a committee hearing. She later issued a clarification following bipartisan backlash.

The latest chapter in Democratic tensions over Israel initially came into view on Tuesday when \$1 billion for the Iron

Dome defense system was included, and then removed, from a larger package House Democrats were rushing to pass in an attempt to suspend the debt limit and avoid a government shutdown. Democratic Rep. Dean Phillips, who is Jewish, was vocal in his disappointment on the measure being removed, and Republicans were quick to call out Democrats even though no GOP lawmakers voted for the overarching bill on Tuesday.

"Speaker Pelosi should not have bowed to the Progressive Caucus and inexplicably removed our longstanding commitment to Israel to help fund the Iron Dome that protects innocent citizens from terrorist rockets from the Continuing Resolution Congress that passed the House," GOP U.S. Rep. Michelle Fischbach said in a statement.

After the defense funding was removed, Democratic House leaders moved quickly to pass a stand-alone Iron Dome bill. Still, Minnesota Democratic Rep. Betty Mc-Collum, who chairs the influential House

Appropriations Subcommittee on Defense and voted for Thursday's bill, noted her "serious concerns as to whether these funds can even be expended with current Iron Dome production levels already at capacity," in a statement.

Omar was also the lone Democrat from Minnesota's House delegation to vote Thursday against the latest



National Defense Authorization Act. Republicans Tom Emmer, Jim Hagedorn and Fischbach also voted no on the bill, which passed with bipartisan support on a 316 to 113 vote. Omar's office pointed out that she has voted against passing the annual legislation ever since taking office back in 2019.

Hedge Funds are Selling Tesla (TSLA) and Buying These 10 EV Stocks Instead

Tesla, Inc. (NASDAQ:TSLA), the California-based electric vehicle (EV) firm led by billionaire Elon Musk, has been, over the past few weeks, feeling the heat of a number of problems that have combined to persuade market experts to short the stock of the company. A global chip shortage has hit the production and delivery numbers of the firm, the National Transportation Safety Board has initiated a fire safety probe into the vehicles made by Tesla after a fatal crash in Florida, and there are increased murmurings about the \$744 billion valuation of the company. Even hedge funds have been selling the stock in anticipation of a correction in the share price. At the end of the second quarter of 2021, 60 hedge funds tracked by Insider Monkey held stakes

worth close to \$9.3 billion in Tesla, Inc.

Latest filings show that Cathie Wood's fund cut its stake in the company by 7% in the second quarter. On September 9, Business Insider, citing Ark's daily transaction reports, reported that three of ARK's funds, including its flagship Ark Innovation ETF, sold a combined 142,708 shares of the EV maker. The total worth of the sold shares was close to \$108 million, in addition to the \$166 million worth of shares sold since late July, the report added.

Burry held PUT options against more than 1 million shares in the company worth over \$731 million, representing 35% of the investment portfolio of his fund, at the end of June 2021. Wood, whose fund owned over 5 million shares in Tesla, Inc. (NASDAQ:TSLA) worth \$3.6 billion at the end of the second quarter, trimmed her stake by 7% in the EV maker when compared to her filings for the first quarter of the year. Chicago-based Citadel Investment Group also has PUT options on more than 21 million shares of the EV maker worth close to \$15 billion. Craig Irwin, senior research analyst at Roth Capital, is one of the market experts with a long-term bearish outlook on the EV maker. In April, during an interview with news platform CNBC, Irwin said Tesla, Inc. (NASDAQ:TSLA) stock was worth just \$150, a 78% discount from the price of the stock at the time, and added that the valuation of the firm was more than the total size of the US and European automotive markets, even though the company was only a "minor player" in the market overall.

Based on our data of 873 hedge funds, 62 funds held stakes in Tesla at the end of June, compared to 60 funds in the previous quarter. In addition, the total value of hedge funds' stakes in Tesla fell to \$9.2 bil-

lion in the second quarter from over \$10 billion in the first quarter.

Its reputation has been tarnished in the last decade, during which its hedged returns couldn't keep up with the unhedged returns of the market indices. GOP Senators Repeatedly Boycott Vote For Muslim Nominee

On July 13, the Senate Small Business Committee was unable to vote on the nomination of Dilawar Syed for deputy administrator of the Small Business Administration. All 10 Republicans boycotted the vote, denying Democrats the quorum they needed to move forward.On July 15, the same thing happened again. And on Tuesday, it happened again.

If confirmed, Syed would become the highest-ranking Muslim official in American history.

And like every other Muslim American in public life, he is facing questions from Republicans about his allegiances, stemming from his religious faith.

The ongoing GOP blockade of Syed shows how GOP efforts to stymie President Joe Biden's nominees have spread to even relatively obscure positions, frustrating the White House. A far smaller percentage of Biden's nominees have won confirmation at this point in his presidency than any of his recent predecessors in the Oval Office.

On June 30, eight of the GOP senators on the committee wrote a letter to the chair, Sen. Ben Cardin (D-Md.), expressing "serious concern" with Syed's work as a board member for Emgage USA. The group and its political arm focus on encouraging more Muslim Americans to vote, increasing political engagement and supporting

The senators called the organization "vocally anti-Israel," noting its support for the right for the boycott, divestment and sanctions movement which urges the international community to isolate Israel in order to gain rights for Palestinians to exist. They said they wanted another hearing to ensure that his confirmation "would not jeopardize small businesses with close ties to Israeli companies or small businesses owned by Jewish Americans." Rand Paul (Ky.), the committee's ranking member, and Todd Young (Ind.) were the two GOP senators who did not sign the June letter. Their offices did not return a request for comment on why. The memo came after a staffer for Sen. Jim Risch (R-Idaho) put together a background document on Syed, obtained by

HuffPost, earlier that month. The very first line noted that Syed was born in Pakistan, and the vast majority of it focused on "very partisan positions" from Emgage not anything said by Syed. (Politico first reported on the memo's existence last

Many of the comments and tweets defended Palestinian human rights and stood up for Muslim lawmakers who have faced criticism. One tweet the Risch staffer highlighted simply said Rep. Ilhan Omar (D-Minn.) should not face death threats. In response to written questions from senators, Syed said he does not support the boycott, divestment and sanctions movement. He also talked about his work engaging with Israeli businesses. Cardin called the ongoing delays "ridicu-

lous." Asked directly if he thought Islamophobia was the root of GOP opposition, he said he could not prove it was.

"When you take a look at those nomi-

nees that have had the most trouble with Republicans, you can't help but notice that they are, in many cases, people of color or women," Cardin told HuffPost in a phone

The Small Business Committee is not typically the site of partisan warfare. Its work during the pandemic to create the Paycheck Protection Program has often been cited as an example of bipartisanship done right. The Senate confirmed each of the past two nominees to be the deputy administrator of SBA, under the Obama and Trump administrations, by voice vote. "I'm baffled that they would pick this nominee in this committee to do a move that is extremely political, extremely partisan," Cardin said. "It's so counter to all the work we've done together."

Syed's qualifications have not come into dispute. He is a businessman currently president and CEO of Lumiata, a health care analytics company who has also stepped into public service roles in both California and at the federal level, leading engagement with small businesses after the passage of the 2009 stimulus package for President Barack Obama's administration. He is also co-founder of AAPI Victory Fund, a super PAC dedicated to mobilizing Asian American voters.

Republican senators have moved away publicly from focusing on Syed's work with Emgage. HuffPost reached out to all 10 members, and none of them responded when asked if they were concerned about his affiliation with the group.

Instead, they all pointed to a joint statement saying they will oppose filling the deputy SBA job until the Biden administration commits to taking back loans given to some Planned Parenthood affiliates under the Paycheck Protection Program. The loans, handed out during President Donald Trump's administration, were meant to help small businesses keep employees on their payroll during the pandemic. Planned Parenthood's affiliates are

nonprofit organizations with leadership and funding structures separate from the national group, but Republicans say they are too closely tied and should not have received the money.

It has been a successive series of things. And if one didn't stick, they found another one. And if that didn't stick, they found another one," said Shekar Narasimhan, a friend of Syed's and co-founder of AAPI Victory Fund.

"What does [Planned Parenthood] have to do with the qualifications of this person in a job that's been unfilled for five years in an agency that everyone agrees could use his help?" he added. "So you have to then go back and ask the very simple question: What could it possibly be? ... And it's got to be that he's Muslim. He's not from here. So therefore by definition, he must not be trustworthy."

Wa'el Alzayat, CEO of Emgage, also pointed out that it's notable that Republicans are holding up Syed's confirmation even though they went ahead and confirmed Isabel Guzman for the top SBA job months ago. Guzman passed out of committee on a bipartisan 15-5 vote.

"The only difference we see is that he's

Muslim," Alzayat said.

Part of the reason Republicans may have shifted away from Syed's background is that they received heavy pushback from Jewish and civil rights groups, including ones dedicated to fighting anti-Semitism. Syed has received vocal and overwhelming support from these organizations.

In July, American Jewish Committee said that while it "does not normally take positions" on nominees, the "accusations around Dilawar Syed's nomination based on his national origin or involvement in a Muslim advocacy organization are so base and unamerican that AJC is compelled to speak out."

And Rabbi Doug Kahn wrote to the committee's leaders about a 2013 trip to Israel that Syed was a part of, praising his participation and calling him "a friend, not an enemy of our community."

"He was an outstanding and thoughtful questioner as a result of his desire to fully understand Israel and the region," Kahn said. "In short, his participation was greatly valued by our delegation of community leaders and enhanced the overall experience for all."

Just last week, the Congressional Asian Pacific American Caucus sent a letter to Cardin and Paul, saying that targeting nominees like Syed "for their faith, ethnicity, or place of birth, furthers the perpetual foreigner stereotype to which AAPIs are constantly subjected."

"Republican Senators are claiming that his faith and background are disqualifying," added CAPAC Chair Rep. Judy Chu (D-Calif.). "This is bigotry plain and simple and the Senate must not have its hands tied by those who spread lies and misinformation."

Some Republicans noted that three Democratic senators also missed the vote this week, implying that they're also to blame for the holdup. But there's no equivalence. All three John Hickenlooper (Colo.), Ed Markey (Mass.) and Jeanne Shaheen (N.H.) told HuffPost they strongly support confirmation and are ready to vote for Syed. And as Cardin said at the start of the meeting on Tuesday, he knew in advance that GOP senators were not going to show up.

"There was, and maybe there still is, an opportunity for Republican leaders to prove the Muslim American community that what happened under Trump was an aberration, and they're failing at that right now," Alzayat said. "We're going to walk away from this experience being fully convinced that the Republican Party has been overtaken by a bigoted and Islamophobic mentality, particularly aimed at the



are committed to turning a new chapter with them, but if they won't even hold a vote, our community will be more than mobilized in the future to make sure that we just have better representation in

It's hard, if not impossible, to find a Muslim American in politics who has not faced bigoted questions about their allegiances or attacks on their faith. Huma Abedin, a top aide to Hillary Clinton, faced accusations about having ties to the Muslim Brotherhood. So did Muslim members of Congress like Reps. Andre Carson (D-Ind.) and former Rep. Keith Ellison (D-Minn.). Reps. Ilhan Omar (D-Minn.) and Rashida Tlaib (D-Mich.) are frequently accused of being anti-Semitic.

When Qasim Rashid, a Muslim attorney in Virginia, ran for public office, he faced death threats and attacks that he was sympathetic to terrorists. He received Emgage's endorsement for his 2020 congressional run in Virginia and has interacted with Syed over the years.

"This obstructionism it's really not just about Syed," he said. "Maybe the GOP hasn't noticed, but we're suffering through a pandemic. We're suffering through massive climate crises. And the SBA manages a trillion dollar portfolio to help small businesses. By denying this extremely qualified candidate a chance to do what he does best, the GOP is ultimately hurting the American people."

And Syed is far from the only nominee facing a holdup. While the Senate is set to confirm a set of Biden nominees with a lengthy series of votes on Thursday night, other Republicans are holding up nominees for the State Department and Pentagon en masse over the administration's handling of the withdrawal from Afghanistan. And a crowded Senate schedule, combined with GOP delay tactics, means relatively few nominees have been

As of Sept. 17, Biden has announced nominees for 465 Senate-confirmed jobs a pace that roughly matches the 498 nominated by George W. Bush and the 432 nominated by Barack Obama in the same time frame. (The slower-moving Trump administration had announced just 338 nominations.) But only 32% of Biden's nominees have been confirmed, compared to 39% for Trump, 58% of Bush and 71% for Obama.






