- Financial and legal documents
- Receipts
- Tax & medical records
- Other personal documents

- Please remove all paperwork out of binders and notebooks.
- There is no need to remove staples or paper clips.
- To prevent sensitive documents from spilling out and blowing away, **all documents must be placed in boxes** that have a lid or be taped shut. No bags please!
- Documents will be shredded on-site. The destroyed documents, in the form of confetti-sized pieces, will be transferred to a recycling facility where it will be recycled and returned to the marketplace in the form of items such as recycled household-paper products.
