Our promise and dedication towards completing the Prayer Shrine in honor of Our Lady of Guadalupe and the Mysteries of the Rosary perseveres and each day brings us closer to its completion. We have included an illustration of the Dedication Plaques to give everyone an image of how they look. The plaques will have a significant placement in the Santuario courtyard as you enter. This phase will begin in the spring of 2024.



This is a picture of the completed mission statue of St. Augustine, just received last week. The life-size bronze depiction has temporarily been placed at the church in Antonito and will eventually be placed at the santuario along with six additional mission statues. The process for the next mission statue will begin as entire donations are complete for each figure. We have volunteers actively seeking contributions for the remaining missions of Ortiz, San Rafael, Las Mesitas, San Miguel, and San Antonio.

In addition to the mission statues surrounding the Shrine and the statue of Our Lady Of Guadalupe and St. Juan Diego at the entrance, walkways will lead visitors to various areas of interest. The placement of new trees will also be available to contributors who are interested in dedicating a tree in memory of a family member similar to what now exists on the New Veterans Boulevard entering the Village of Conejos.

MASS READING REFLECTION

FIRST READING  
Is 50:4-7  
[Christ's Suffering]

This reading is taken from the third song of the Servant of Yahweh. As mentioned at the feast of the Baptism of our Lord, it is not clear whom the inspired writer had in mind when he composed these four songs, describing the ideal Servant (Son) of God. Is he a collective person: Israel, God's people? Is he a king of the past or the Messiah (anointed king) to come? In any case, the Christian community applied these hymns very early to Jesus and they are used throughout Holy Week as a beautiful commentary on the passion narratives. Indeed, "the Son of Man [Jesus] did not come to be served but to serve and to give his life as a ransom for many". (Mt 20:28).

SECOND READING  
Phil 2:6-11  
[Humility]

This text is actually a Christ hymn, sung in church. It beautifully describes our Lord's utmost humiliation, which he suffered on the cross. By being obedient, he made up for our sinful disobedience. But this hymn sings also of Christ's exaltation by the Father. Meditating on the Lord's suffering and death, as Christians do during Holy Week, we should keep both sides of the Christ event in mind. It is suffering-and-death that actually constitutes a passage to exaltation.

Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord



Theme: Death and Life

Great people were often controversial figures during their lifetime. It is history, which can look on from a distance and see things in proper perspective, that rectifies the often limited judgment of contemporaries. Something like this has happened to the Lord Jesus. His contemporaries, even his closest coworkers, did not understand him, especially not his strange ideas on suffering and death as a necessary passage to a better life. Only later did all of this become clear to them. Today Christians celebrate Palm Sunday. "For it was to accomplish this mystery [of Christ's Passion and Resurrection] that he entered his own city of Jerusalem" (Procession Rite). The triumphal entry celebrated at the beginning of the passion-week emphasizes that the three elements: suffering, death, and resurrection, belong together. Jesus' death was not a defeat. It was a victory. It is the genuine insight of Christianity that the events of Jesus' earthly life were the execution of God's saving purpose. This genuine insight should be ours also concerning our own lives, when suffering strikes us. How do you deal with suffering in your life and when you encounter fellow humans who die in suffering and distress? Paul states: "If we believe that Jesus died and rose, so too will God, through Jesus, bring with him those who have fallen asleep" (1 Thes 4:14). "O Lord... through the death of your Son you have brought us to hope for what we believe, so by his Resurrection... lead us to where you call!" (Prayer after Communion).

How to Observe Palm Sunday

Sunday Mass on Palm Sunday includes two readings from the Gospels. We hear about when Jesus entered Jerusa-lem at the start of Mass. And we read the entire Passion account during the Liturgy of the Word. A great way to start your Holy Week is by reflecting on Jesus’ passion. After attending Mass it’s common to display the palm branch you received at Mass! Some place it behind a cruci-fix, some take several palm branches and weave them together to create a palm cross. Since palm branches are a blessed item they should not be thrown in the trash. If you do not want to keep your branch you can return it to the church where it will be burned for ashes the following Ash Wednesday. It’s also common to deep clean your home on Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday. This tradition arises from the Jewish custom of preparing the home for Passover. Holy Week is also a great time to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation - many churches have increased opportunities for Confession during this time.

A Prayer for Holy Thursday

Jesus, In these last few days leading up to Easter, as I recall your passion and death, let me remem-ber that, above all, I am called to feed your sheep. You have given me a model of how to live; may I strive to be all that you created me for, spreading the love of God and the truth of our Catholic faith wherever I am able. You are the way, the truth, and the life. **Amen.**

A Prayer for Good Friday

Jesus, No one knows change better than you. You died on the cross, and three days later you rose from the dead. Forty days later you ascend-ed into heaven and left the world transformed for the rest of time. Help me to transform my soul, to die to sin and death and be reborn in your love and eternal life. **Amen.**

A Prayer for Holy Saturday

Jesus, You are courage incarnate. As you hung on the cross for my sins and the sins of the world, you showed me that all things are possible. You knew that life did not end on the cross. It was only the beginning of a new and glorious eternal life. **Amen.**
