### MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 30

Today on Nature's Neighbor, Melanie shared a number of tips regarding the changing weather on the farm and in the garden. She also let her listeners know

about an important harvest event coming up and the Intro to Beekeeping classes at Nature's Touch. Here's the info...

Intro to **"THE HIVE & THE HONEY BEE"** – October 15

This introductory class is available on the third Tuesday from October thru December and is required to participate in the full series called "The Art of Keeping Bees" that begins on January 21st and runs thru June. The six-month series will be taught by a local beekeeping expert who will explain how to set up, maintain, and harvest your own Apiary (Bee Yard). Well-kept bees are incredibly important to a healthy ecosystem and this series will provide you with all the information necessary to farm your own honey. Participants will learn about (a) flora and fauna, (b) the installation of boxes, (c) bee colony structure and health, (d) how to manage overcrowding, (e) managing bees for honey production, (f) the stacking and sorting of supers, (g) recognizing bee behavior, and (h) the harvesting of honey. The Consent Agenda includes a scheduled airline use and lease agreement between the County Airport and Contour Airlines providing flights four (4) days per week between SLO and Las Vegas. It also contains a request to approve a change in computer platforms for Behavioral Health's Electronic Health records at a cost of \$1,848,650 with possible amendments of up to twenty-five (25) percent of the amount of the agreement. Both items require a 4/5 vote. Also on the Consent Agenda is the submittal of a resolution recognizing October 6-12 as "National 4-H Week".

Under Board Business, one item stands out. In the afternoon, the Board will review the feasibility study regarding Community Choice Aggregation as provided by Monterey Bay Community Power and give staff direction on the next steps regarding Community Choice Aggregation. In plain English, they will review a study on the pros and cons of signing up all power users within the County's purview with Monterey Bay Community Power and then either ask staff to proceed or to shelve the idea. There is a great deal of pressure on the County to join.
