Please remember that work cannot be performed nor equipment operated prior to 8:00 a.m. It is not only a violation of Village ordinance, but unfair to fellow residents living in close proximity to your premises. It is truly our intent to maintain the charm and high quality of life associated with Woodsburgh. Kindly remind your landscapers that they require an annual permit, which can be obtained at the Village Hall. These regulations will be strictly enforced and we sincerely appreciate your assistance and cooperation regarding this matter.

I am not sure if you have noticed, but as part of our beautification program we have been lighting all of the "Welcome to Woodsburgh" signs at the entrances of our community. Tony has done a terrific job installing the lighting and required solar equipment to power them. We will continue this and many other improvements, plantings and refurbishments as needed to directly enhance the overall charm and beauty of the Village.

Our Village is scheduled to have the streets swept the first week in May (weather permitting). Please try to keep all vehicles off the streets during that time so that the sweeper can do a thorough job. We will send notification utilizing blackboard connect a day prior. Additionally, as the weather improves we can begin repairing our roadways to fix the damage that has occurred over the winter months to village streets. Please notify village hall with any specific areas of interest that may require attention.
